'Robber' beaten to death

A suspected robber was killed in a mob beating at Dakkhin Maijbaria village in Sadar upazila early yesterday. The identity of the deceased could not be known immediately. Police said, a gang swooped on the house of one Abdul Kader of the village at around 3:00am. Hearing the hue and cry, locals chased the robbers and caught one of them while the rest managed to flee. The mob then gave him a good beating, leaving him critically injured. He was rushed to Feni Sadar Hospital where he died after sometime, said Mosharaf Hossain, assistant sub-inspector at Feni Sadar Model police Station.

They blamed a section of corrupt officials and employees at the gas office in the town for creating the gas crisis by selling gas to the industries and CNG stations.

They also threatened to go for tougher programmes if the problem was not resolved within seven days. The programmes include

Dhaka-Aricha road blockade and laying siege to the district gas office.

Two Jubo League activists arrested in Patuakhali

Two Jubo League men were arrested on Monday night on charge of raping a 35year-old housewife at Nijkata village under Rangabali upazila of the district.

Following a case filed by the victim on Monday, five days after the incident, Rangabali Police arrested Md Kawsar, 28, general secretary of Jubo League Mowdubi union unit, and Jahir, 27, a member of the unit, from their houses at the same village.

In the case statement, the

victim stated that as her husband had gone fishing on the Bay, she along with her three daughters was asleep at their house. "Taking advantage of his absence, Kawsar and Jahir entered the house by breaking open the door at midnight on February 13 and raped me in front of my daughters," she said.

The victim along with her husband came to Patuakhali Police Station on Monday and told the law enforcers about the incident. Being informed by Patuakhali police, Rangabali Police Police quoted locals as Station recorded the case the same day and arrested the Jubo League men.
