Bodies of missing crew found

The bodies of the two missing crew were recovered from the sunken clinker-laden vessel yesterday. Divers of Mongla Port Authority (MPA) and Bangladesh Navy recovered the bodies of Murad Sheikh, son of Abu Sheikh, and Shahadat Sheikh, 22, son of Kanchan Sheikh of Dhalaierchar village in Alfadanga upazila of Faridpur at around 1:15pm. The vessel could not be salvaged from Passur River as of 5:00pm yesterday. According to Mongla Port Authority, the vessel, MV Moksedpur, with 10 crew on board, sank in the river near the port when it was unloading clinker from a mother vessel at around 6:00pm on Sunday morning. Crew Murad and Shahadat went missing while the rest eight managed to swim ashore.

Under trial prisoner dies

An under-trial prisoner of Jessore Central Jail died early yesterday. The deceased, Mizanur Rahman, 40, of Munshipara village under Monirampur upazila, was an accused in two murder cases. Jailer Kamrul Huda said Mizan complained of chest pain at around 1:30am. He was immediately taken to Jessore Medical College Hospital where the doctors declared him dead, the jailer added.

25 houses gutted

At least 25 houses were gutted in a fire in Purba Gopinathpur area of the city yesterday noon. Fifteen people were injured in the fire incident. Locals said the fire originated from the kitchen of one Hamidul Islam's house and soon engulfed the adjoining dwellings. On information, fire fighters from Rangpur fire service station rushed to the spot and doused the blaze after one and a half hours frantic efforts, said Tanharul Islam, senior officer of the station. The loss caused by the fire could go up to Tk 1 crore, he said.

Bigoted man arrested

Police arrested a bigoted man from a mehfil (a religious gathering) at Mahmud Kathi Bazar in Nesarabad upazila on Sunday night on charge of criticising alleged write-ups of slain Shahbagh activist Ahmed Rajib Haidar regarding Islam. The arrestee was identified as Mawlana Mozammel Haque of Mathbaria upazila. Locals said, police arrested Mozammel while he was addressing the mehfil saying government, Shahbagh activists and bloggers, including Rajib, dement Islam. The listeners at the programme then moved towards Nesarabad police station, protesting the arrest. When they reached Ali Kadam Government Primary School area, a group of local Chhatra League and Jubo League men protested their move, triggering a clash. At least eight people from both sides were injured during the clash. Of them, two were admitted to the hospital while the rest given first aid. Haji Mohammad Sadekul, president of managing committee of the mehfil, said police arrested Mozammel while he was delivering speech against the Shahbagh movement and its activists.

Jamaat office set afire

ATM booth of Islami Bank vandalised

A gang set fire to an office of Jamaat-e-Islami in the district town early yesterday.

Witnesses said, some unidentified people entered the three-storey building, housing the publicity and publication office and store-room of the party, at Chak Farid in Colony area around 4:00am by breaking open a window.

Later they set fire to two rooms of the party office.

The building also houses a mosque and an orphanage run by Jamaat-backed Darus Suffah Trust.

A motorbike, some furniture of the office and a number of books on the party were gutted in the fire.

Nazim Uddin, secretary of Bogra district Jamaat unit, alleged that the people who have been leading the Gonojagoron Mancha might have set their office on fire.

Kawser Ali, a fire service official, however, said the fire originated from an elec-

tric short circuit at a room of the office and soon spread to another adjacent room.

On information, a firefighting unit of the town rushed in and doused the blaze after one hour's frantic efforts at about 5:00am, he said.

In Jessore, a group of unruly youths vandalised an ATM booth of Islami Bank at Noapara Bazar on Sunday evening, reports

Abdus Salek, officer in-charge (OC) of Abhoynagar PS, said a procession brought out by anti-hartal supporters was passing by the bank's Noapara branch in the evening.

At that time, a section of youths from the procession threw brickbats at the branch office and vandalised its ATM booth.

Road mishap triggers protest

Road communication was disrupted with several districts for about five hours as angry villagers blocked Dinajpur-Dhaka highway following a road accident yesterday morning.

The road link was restored at 2:10pm after police built two speed breakers at Rajapur of the highway.

With the new two, the number of speed breakers went up to 42 on the 35km highway between Dinajpur and Phulbari upazila.

Police quoting locals of the area said that a crowded passenger bus was coming to Dinajpur from Gaibandha yesterday. The bus lost control at Rajapur point of Sadar upazila at around 9.00am as one of its front tyres went out of order causing the vehicle to hit roadside trees, leaving at least 25 passengers injured.

Twelve of the injured

were rushed to Dinajpur Medical College and Hospital. They are Ruma, 25, Kariyam, 25, Khurshida Begum, 25, Md. Sharwar Begum, 40, Sadi M o h a m m a d, 40, Makferatun, 40, Shamsiya, 18, Abdul Salam, 65, Hasina Banu, 55, Aleya, 35, Md. Abdul Hakim, 50, and Awara Begum, 35.

The accident triggered agitation among the locals who put up a road barricade with logs, leaving nearly 200 vehicles on both side of the highway stranded.

At around 11.30am, police took an attempt to disperse the agitators but failed. Later they built two speed breakers on the highway as demanded by the villagers.

2000 Jamaat-Shibir men sued in Pabna

Kushtia Sadar Ameer held

Police in Pabna have filed four separate cases against 2,000 activists of Jamaat-e-Islami and its student front Islami Chhatra Shibir in connection with the Saturday's clash.

The Jamaat-Shibir clash with police during the half-day hartal enforced by Jamaat in the district left two people dead, reports UNB.

Noor-e-Alam, officer-in-charge (operations) of Pabna Sadar PS, filed three cases and Samar Kumar, sub-inspector of the same police station, filed another case accusing 2,000 people on Saturday night.

The accused include some top leaders of Pabna Jamaat, police said. Police also arrested

Ameer of Kushtia Sadar upazila unit Jamaat-e-Islami Mosarraf Hossain yesterday.

Mosarraf, also Kushtia Sadar upazila chairman, was the prime accused in a case filed on 5 November 2012 for attack on law enforcers, reports our correspondent.

Two teams from Kushtia Model police station and Detective Branch (DB) of Kushtia arrested him soon after he came out of a meeting held at upazila complex at about 1:30pm.

According to police, Jamaat men attacked the on duty police during their rally in NS Road in the town on November 5 last year.

Police sued 62 Jamaat-Shibir activists with Kushtia Model police station on the same night.

Villagers attack policemen suspecting them robbers

Villagers attacked and confined a police team suspecting them as robbers when they went to arrest an accused at Ambarnagar village in Sonaimuri upazila early yesterday.

ASP Mahbul Alam of Begumganj circle along with five policemen went to a house at Ambarnagar village to arrest accused Iqbal around 2:00am.

Seeing the team, Iqbal and his wife informed the villagers over phone that robbers attacked their house.

Within a few minutes, a group of villagers rushed to the house. They besieged the house and started pelting brick chips at the law enforcers, injuring Alam, his driver and three villagers.

Angry villagers also held the police team hostage and set fire to a police van.

On information, additional police forces from Begumganj and Senbagh police stations rushed to the spot and rescued the police officers from the villagers around 4:00am after a negotia-

tion with them.

The ASP said that the incident occurred when they raided the house to arrest Iqbal in a case filed for killing a son of one Gafur Master of the village.

Confirming the incident, Humayun Kabir officer-in-charge of Sonaimuri police station, said the policemen were rescued and the situation was now under control.

Police arrested 20 people, including Shahida Akter, wife of Iqbal, in connection with the incident, the OC added.
