

# Put 4 shutdown local trains into service again

## Gaibandha people demand

Gaibandha Nagorik Parishad yesterday demanded immediate restoration of services by four shut down local trains on Santahar-Lalmonirhat-Dinajpur routes.

The leaders of the Parishad submitted a memorandum to the divisional railway manager (DRM), Lalmonirhat in this regard.

Abdul Wahed Mandol, stationmaster of Gaibandha, received the memorandum on behalf of the DRM.

According to the memo, the authorities of western railway closed operation of the trains on the plea of acute manpower shortage, causing immense sufferings to the passengers of Bogra, Gaibandha, Lalmonirhat, Rangpur, Dinajpur and other northern districts.

On December 18 last year, the authorities closed operation of local 481-up and 482-down trains on Lalmonirhat-Santahar route via Gaibandha and Bogra in the morning shift, showing

acute shortage of loco-masters.

Earlier, the authorities closed up and down trains of 'Ramsagar Express' shutting Bonarpara-Thakurgaon route via Gaibandha, Rangpur and Dinajpur on August 23, 2011 on the same ground.

Due to the shut down, a large number of commuters, including students and employees, cannot attend their offices and classes timely.

Besides, various traders of remote areas face untold troubles while going to the district town with vegetables and other perishable items, said the speakers at the programme.

Earlier, separate protest programmes, including human chain, were held to realise the demand, they said.

They also threatened to go for tougher programme if the demand was not met immediately.

Among others, Sirajul Islam Babu, convener of Gaibandha Nagorik Parishad and its member-secretary Ariful Islam Babu, spoke.

# 300 suffer as exam centre 17km away from homes

As many as 317 candidates from four schools in Mohalchhari upazila are facing an untold suffering as they have been appearing in the ongoing SSC exams at a centre more than 17km away from their areas.

Of the candidates, 125 take the test from Maischhari High School, 36 from Ultachhari High School, 69 from Lamuchhari High School, and 87 from Boddha High School.

Candidates said they

leave their houses by 7:00am to catch bus or jeep that takes almost three hours to reach the centre through a muddy and hilly road.

"Sometimes we have to travel on the roof of a jam-packed bus or jeep, risking our lives. We feel tired after the journey and cannot answer the questions properly," some of the candidates told this correspondent during his visit to the lone exam centre in the upazila on Tuesday.

Shamita Chakma, an examinee from Maischhari High School, said she goes to the centre by bus or jeep on the exam day. "I feel exhausted and suffer from headache," she added.

Adarshi Chakma, an examinee from Ultachhari High School, said she has to leave their house at least three and a half hours before the exam begins. "I miss the time for last-

minute revision as I have to reach the bus stand by 6:45am," she said.

Mongdu Marma, father of an examinee of Maischhari High School, said as most of the guardians are poor, they cannot afford to rent houses at Mahalchhari upazila headquarters during the SSC examinations.

Sona Ratan Chakma, chairman of Mohalchhari Upazila Parishad, said an SSC examination centre in Maischhari area is needed to mitigate the sufferings of the candidates of the four schools. "I will request the authorities concerned to arrange an exam centre in the area," the UZ chairman said.

Karunamoy Chakma, headmaster of Maischhari High School, said they wrote to the authorities concerned several times demanding an SSC exams centre in Maischhari area, but to no effect.

# YOUTH MURDER IN THAKURGAON

## JCD leader, 10 others sued

Eleven people, including three activists of district unit Jatiyatabadi Chhatra Dal (JCD), were sued yesterday on charge of killing a youth.

Among the accused are Masudul Islam alias Munna, 28, organising secretary of JCD unit, his younger brother Emran Alam Siddiqi alias Dipu, 28, Md Selim, former treasurer of the unit, Md Sohel, 30, an activist, of the town.

Kohinur Begum, mother of deceased Rafiqul Islam, 26, of Gowlapara in the town filed the case with Sadar police station.

Police said, a gang led by Munna on Monday night forcibly took Rafiqul to a room of Kalibari Shamyao Krira O Shangkritik Goshthi from Thakurgaon Judge Court compound over a previous enmity. In the club's room, Munna, his brother Dipu and some other youths stabbed

Rafiqul indiscriminately, leaving him critically injured.

Later, local people brought Rafiqul to Thakurgaon Sadar Hospital. He was referred to Rangpur Medical College and Hospital but succumbed to his injuries at Birgani upazila of Dinajpur on the way to Rangpur.

Police were raiding different areas to arrest the accused, said superintendent of police Md Foyzal Mahmud.
