

India train derails; 2 killed

AFP, New Delhi

At least two people were killed and many feared injured when a Bangalore-bound train derailed in southern India yesterday morning, a railways official told AFP.

VJ Accamma, a spokesman for Southern Railways, confirmed the death of at least two people in the accident, which occurred just after dawn in the small village of Chitteri in the southern state of Tamil Nadu.

The train was on its way from the town of Muzaffarpur in eastern India to the suburb of Yeshwantpur in the southern technology hub of Bangalore, he said.

UN condemns Indian peacekeepers' killing

Members of the UN Security Council have condemned in the strongest terms the killing of five Indian peacekeepers on South Sudan and asked that the perpetrators be brought to justice.

The members condemned the April 9 attack by unidentified armed persons on a UN Mission in South Sudan (UNMISS) convoy in Jonglei, South Sudan, in which five Indian peacekeepers and at least seven civilians were killed, said a press statement.

The members of the Security Council expressed

their condolences to the families of the peacekeepers and the UNMISS staff killed in the attack, as well as to the government of India.

They called on the government of South Sudan to swiftly investigate the incident and bring the perpetrators to justice.

The members of the Security Council reiterated their full support for UNMISS and the troop contributing countries and called on all parties in South Sudan to cooperate with the mission.

Earlier, UN leader Ban Ki-moon said that a war crimes

investigation could be launched into the attack.

Ban "recalls that the killing of peacekeepers is a war crime that falls under the jurisdiction of the International Criminal Court," said his spokesman Martin Nesirky.

Meanwhile, Indian Prime Minister Manmohan Singh yesterday expressed anguish over incident.

Jonglei has been the scene of widespread ethnic conflict since South Sudan became independent in July 2011. Much of the trouble has been in Pibor county, where the UN peacekeeping force is based.

Pak cop killed in anti-polio attack

A Pakistani policeman was shot dead and another was wounded yesterday while escorting a polio vaccination team in the country's northwest, local officials said.

No one has claimed responsibility for the killings, but the Pakistani Taliban last year banned polio vaccinations in the tribal region of Waziristan, alleging the campaign was a cover for espionage.

Wednesday's killing happened in the Parhoti neighbourhood of the town of Mardan on the second day of a three-day local anti-polio campaign.

Refrain from destructive

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activities. Don't play with fire and the life of people. Let the people live peacefully. Why are you pushing the country into darkness again?" she questioned.

The prime minister made the comments when hartal victim Antu Barua and her parents called on the premier at Gono Bhaban in the afternoon.

Antu suffered injuries in her right eye in bomb explosions during the hartal enforced by the opposition in Chittagong on March 28.

Hasina said her government has curbed militancy and terrorism with an iron hand during the last four years, but the terrorists of BNP and Jamaat-Shibir are unleashing violence again through killing common people and torching and vandalising public and private property.

During hartals, common people become the victims of violence, she mentioned adding that, even Antu and her mother could have died in the bomb attack.

The prime minister talked to Antu and her parents and assured them of providing all possible help to continue her treatment. She also gave financial

assistance to Antu.

PM's International Affairs Adviser Gowher Rizvi, State Minister for Women and Children Affairs Shirin Sharmin Chowdhury, eminent journalist Baby Moudud, PM's Military Secretary Maj Gen Mia Md Jainul Abedin and special assistants Abdus Sobhan Golap and Mahbubul Hoque Shakil were present.

Antu, 14, a student of Opornacharan City Corporation Girls High School, sustained injuries when splinters of bombs hit her right eye at Momen Road in Kotwali area of Chittagong, when she along with her mother was going to a coaching centre.

Cambodia yesterday said it would downsize its Khmer Rouge war crimes tribunal, following a shortage of funds that disrupted a major trial of former top regime leaders.

He was unable to say how many of the 400 employees would be affected.

Alim aided Pak army

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witness in Alim's case, Mozammel told the court that the victims became the target of Alim merely for supporting the AL.

He and his family members were compelled to leave the country in the face of "torture" committed by the accomplices of "Razakar commander" Abdul Alim in 1971.

The 65-year-old witness from Chakbarkat Sonarpara village under Joypurhat Sadar upazila gave a heart-rending description of how he was picked up from the yard of a mosque, tortured and hacked by the Pakistani army.

The three-member tribunal led by Justice Obaidul Hassan recorded the testimony before adjourning the case proceedings until today, when he will face cross-examination by the defence.

Mozammel, who was a farmer at a village near the Indian border, said as the Pakistani army entered Joypurhat in 1971, accomplices of Razakar commander Alim started torturing local people on his instructions.

Being frightened, he along with his family mem-

bers left the country in the second week of Baishakh and took refuge at Pirich refugee camp in India. But Mozammel returned home the following Friday.

On Friday of the first week of Ashar, Mozammel went to the mosque in his village. But when he came out of the mosque, the Pakistani army along with Peace Committee member Riaz Mridha took him and 20 others to nearby Birala village.

On the way, the Pakistani army employed them and around 500 more people to pull up an army vehicle from a ditch. The vehicle had plunged into the ditch in a mine attack, said Mozammel.

Later, the occupation army took all of them to Chakpahananda village and lined them up.

"Peace Committee member Riaz Mridha pulled out a list from his pocket and gave it to the Pakistani army. In Urdu, he said Alim Shaheb had given him the list," mentioned the witness.

According to the list, the Pakistani army called out the names of 28 people, including Mozammel, and released others. Then the group was hit with rifle butts and taken to the house of one Afaz with their hands tied.

A little later, soldiers forced them to dig a big hole near the house. When the job was done around 7:00pm, army men again confined them in the house.

Soldiers then took them near the big hole and hacked them severely before kicking them into the hole one after another. Mozammel was among the last eight who were pushed into the hole.

"At first, they [soldiers] pulled me by my hair and

threw me to the ground. Then they hacked me with a large machete on my right shoulder and throat," said Mozammel, showing his injury marks to the court.

Several of his teeth were broken as soldiers hit his jaw and kicked him into the hole. Due to the brutal torture, he fell unconscious there.

"After sometime, I regained my senses and found some people were groaning in the hole," mentioned Mozammel.

Later he managed to flee from the hole and went to India where he underwent treatment at Balurghat Hospital for three months. He also had to receive treatment at Gangarampur Hospital for full recovery.

He again went to Pirich refugee camp and found five surviving victims of his group.

The 22 victims were buried in the mass grave [hole], said Mozammel.

KAMARUZZAMAN'S CASE The tribunal for the third consecutive day yesterday adjourned the case proceedings of Jamaat-e-Islami leader Muhammad Kamaruzzaman as none of his senior counsels appeared before it.

Yesterday had been fixed for the deposition of the defence, but a junior counsel sought adjournment of the proceedings saying that senior counsels could not appear due to "unavoidable situation."

The court fixed today for the arguments.

Kamaruzzaman is facing seven charges of committing crimes against humanity during the Liberation War.

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countries to reduce migration costs as the private agencies charge job seekers huge sums of money, mentioned Mosharraf.

The government has fixed Tk 40,000 each for migrating to Malaysia under state arrangements. Private recruiters, though, usually charge a job seeker Tk 2,50,000 to Tk 3,00,000.

Yesterday, a meeting of the Parliamentary Standing Committee on Expatriate Welfare and Overseas Employment Ministry was held with its Chairman Anisul Islam Mahmud in the chair.

Talking to this correspondent, Anisul said Baira should cooperate with the ministry because the government was working to ensure transparency in the sector.

"The government was trying to reduce migration costs. When the total migration process will be brought

under a legal framework, Baira will get opportunity to work here," he observed.

Khandker Mosharraf said Baira can explore foreign job markets and work with the ministry. "We are only sending workers to Malaysia under government to government arrangement. They (Baira) can send job seekers to 156 more countries if they can bring job demands from abroad."

But Baira must send workers to any Middle-Eastern country at a maximum of Tk 20,000, he noted adding that the government can send workers there at a cost of Tk 15,000.

Contacted, Baira Secretary General Ali Haider Chowdhury said, "We have always said that we are not opposing the government's plan to send workers under state arrangements. Rather, we are seeking cooperation from the ministry to work together."
