Kidnapped girl rescued

Police have rescued a Hindu schoolgirl, who was kidnapped about two months ago from Baufal village. Police rescued her from Matuail of Jatrabari in Dhaka on Friday night and arrested two people in this connection. The arrestees are Feroz *alias* Nayan, 20, son of Ruhul Bayatee of Birpasha village and Forkan, 25, of the same village. Family and police sources said, Feroz *alias* Nayan, wanted to marry the 14-year-old girl of class eight but her family refused the proposal. On February 5, a gang led by Nayan kidnapped the girl from in front of her house. The gang kidnapped my daughter and Nayan married her forcibly after converting her into a Muslim, father of the victim claimed.

Housewife murdered

A housewife was stabbed to death allegedly by her husband and in-laws at Satpakia village in Sadar upazila on Friday. The deceased was identified as Dilruba Begum, 35. Police and witnesses said Dilruba's husband Uzzal Miah and her in-laws stabbed her following a family feud, leaving her critically injured in the morning. She was first taken to Jamalpur General Hospital and then shifted to Mymensingh Medical College Hospital where she succumbed to her wounds in the afternoon. Victim's father Dudu Miah filed a murder case.

Two electrocuted

Two people died from electrocution at Paranganj village in Sadar upazila yesterday. The deceased were identified as Jahangir Alam, son of Mofiz Uddin of Dakir Kanda village, and Sarwar Alam, son of Samar Ali of Baghdadoba village of the same upazila. Officer in-charge (OC) of Mymensingh Model police station Fazlul Karim said, Sarwar got injured when he came in contact with a live electric wire lying on a road on Saturday night following a storm. Jahangir also was injured when he went to save Sarwar. Local people rushed the two to Mymensingh Medical College Hospital where they succumbed to their injuries in the morning.

Stop fratricidal conflict among political parties in CHT

Urge citizens' bodies in Rangamati, Bandarban

Leaders of Chittagong Hill Tracts Citizen's Committee (CHTCC) yesterday brought out a procession in the town and formed a human chain in New Court Building area calling to stop 'fratricidal conflict' between the local political parties.

Shun politics of killing and abduction, practice democracy. Organise all political programmes in a peaceful manner. Killing and kidnapping own brothers cannot resolve any problem, said the leaders of the citizen's body.

We want to live in peace, so hold dialogue across the table for your own interest, they said, pointing at pro-peace Parbattya Chattagram Jana Sanghati Samity (PCJSS), anti-peace treaty United People's Democratic Front (UPDF) and Manabendra Narayan Larma faction of PCJSS.

Violation of human rights in the hills is on the rise and it has become a regular phenomenon in the recent days. Killing and kidnapping by the three factions -- PCJSS, UPDF and MN Larma -- is taking place in the region almost every other day.

Junma people are being killed by their own brothers, many women are becoming widow while youths becoming orphans, they lamented.

So, we can't sit idle any more. It is high time to stop fighting between the brothers. Existences of Junma people will be at stake if the infighting continued, they said.

Expressing grave concern, the leader said that 15 years have elapsed since signing of the peace deal. But the vital clauses still remained unimplemented, causing misunderstanding among the local political parties, they said.

They demanded full implementation of the

peace deal and called upon the indigenous people to be united to launch a greater movement to realise their demands including solution of land disputes.

Chaired by Goutam Dewan, president of CHT Citizen's Committee, the human chain was also addressed by Dr. Manik Lal Dewan, former dean of Bangladesh Agriculture University, Jagat Jyoti Chakma, former chairman of Rangamati Hill District Council, Nirupa Dewan, member of National Human

Rights Commission and women leader Tuku Talukder.

A similar human chain was formed in Bandarban district yesterday.

Organised by the citizen's body it was held in the district town where the leaders urged both the political parties to practice democracy instead of violence, reports our correspondent.

Former councillor of BHDC U Nai Shai Prue, Chala Prue Jimmy, Danai Prue Nali and Uttara Tripura addressed to programme.

Campaign heats up for Magura mayoral by-poll

Although the campaign for the mayoral by-poll of the Magura municipality has been geared up, dedicated activists and supporters of both Awami League (AL) and BNP are still confused about their rebel candidates.

The by-election is scheduled to be held on May 6.

The mayoral post fell vacant following the death of former Mayor Mohammad Altaf Hossain. The last municipality election was held on 27 January 2011.

The candidates in the fray are: Khurshid Haider Tutul (AL backed), Tapon Roy (AL rebel group backed), Dr. Mahbulul Haque Siddiquee (BNP backed), Iqbal Akhter Khan (BNP rebel group backed) and advocate Hasan Seraj Suja (Jatiys Party backed).

Dedicated leaders of both AL and BNP have expressed their frustration over their respective party's rebel candidatures.

Contacted, Dr. Mohammad Serajul Akbar, MP as well as the general secretary of Magura district unit AL, however said, "Tapon Roy did not seek party support as he resigned from the party in 2012. Four others sought backing in writing from the party and three of them withdrew their candidacy in support of Khurshid Haider Tutul".

President of district unit

BNP Kabir Murad told this correspondent, "Kafur was never a BNP candidate as he did not hold any party post. Our party has unanimously decided to back Dr. Mahbulul Haque Siddiquee", he added.

As the candidates of both major parties are facing internal feud, JP backed candidate advocate Hasan Seraj Suja is enjoying its advantage. Moreover, there is no squabble or confusion in his organisation.

"As our candidate advocate Suja has a clean image and the party is out of any internal conflict, we hope to be able to achieve our target to win the municipal mayoral post", said Khan Ziaul Haque, president of district unit JP.

Boy drowns in Meghna

A schoolboy drowned in Meghna River yesterday.

According to his classmates, Nahidul Islam, 14, went to Tulatoli point of the Meghna at noon to take a bath along with his classmates.

While swimming there, a current swept three of them. Two of his classmate survived but Nahid failed to swim ashore.

Later coast guards found him 200 yards away from the spot and sent him to hospital where the duty doctor declared him dead.

Hefajat holds meeting in Kushtia today defying ban

Hefajat-e-Islami has declared that it would hold a public meeting in the district today defying a ban by the local administration on any gathering.

Abdul Khaleque, general secretary of the religious body, read out a statement in this regard at a press conference held at the office of Khelafat Andolon Kushtia district unit on Saturday evening.

The Hefajat leader said that they sought permission on April 18 to hold the meeting on Kushtia public library ground on April 28. But on Saturday, the local administration informed them that they cannot hold the meeting, he said.

Contacted, Additional Police Superintendent Joyanal Abedin told this correspondent that police did not grant permission to them for fear of deterioration of law and order.

Meanwhile, police deployed additional forces at different points of the town.

The Islamist organisation will hold a grand rally on Eidgah ground in Tangail tomorrow to press their 13-point demand.

Tangail district unit of the organisation held a press conference at Dhulcherar Madrasa in the town yesterday to brief local journalists about the programme, reports our correspondent.

Mufti Abdur Rahman, member secretary of the district unit Hefajat, read out the announcement.

The leaders of the organisation said that Hefajat-e-Islam is a non-political organisation and so it has no political agenda.

In Dinajpur, Hefajat leaders at a rally yesterday said that the Awami League government had no right to stay in power any further as they failed to run the country smoothly.

They also asked the government to quit power before May 5, reports our correspondent.
