







DEVASTATION LEFT BY HEFAJAT

1) Partly burnt pages from Islamic textbooks laid out in front of the south gate of Baitul Mukarram Mosque in the capital yesterday. A number of footpath bookshops along the national mosque were set ablaze by Hefajat-e Islam activists during their rampage throughout Sunday. 2) The remains of the burnt bookstores. 3) Protesters being ejected from Shapla Chattar in the capital early yesterday where they gathered to demand implementation of their 13-point charter of demands. 4) Stumps of trees sawed off by Hefejat men to put up a blockade at Bijoynagar. 5) A banner hung by street hawkers in Purana Paltan reads their demand for punishment for the arsonists who burnt their makeshift shops on the footpaths. 6) Body of a policeman in Dhaka Medical College Hospital. He died in a clash with Hefajat protesters near Kanchpur Bridge yesterday. 7) A shopping centre near Baitul Mukarram Mosque vandalised by the demonstrators. 8) Common people chasing away Hefajat men on Dhaka-Chittagong highway in Rayerbagh yesterday. 9) The burnt and vandalised Baitul Muqarram Market. 10) The charred remains of a bus at the north gate of Baitul Mukarram Mosque. 11) Hefejat men clash with law enforcers in Hathazari upazila in Chittagong yesterday.
