## Injured couple die

A couple who were injured in a fire at the capital's Mugda on May 23 succumbed to their injuries in the last two days. Their three-year-old orphaned son Anisuzzaman Apurba

is fighting for life in Dhaka Medical College Hospital with 80 percent burns to his body. Anwaruzzaman Shipon, a confectionary shop owner, died on Tuesday, while his wife Faria Zaman Mou outlived him by a day only. The couple had sustained 50 percent

burns in a gas explosion in their home and were admitted to the Intensive Care Unit of DMCH. The explosion left four people injured. The fourth victim, Arman, 7, a neighbour of the couple, also died on

Tuesday. Police said a gas leak from a water tank had caused the explosion. They suspected that the fire started when Shipon lit a cigarette. In hospital bed, Mou, however, had claimed that an exploded electric-fan led to the accident.


