

CMCH interns call off strike

Interns of Chittagong Medical College Hospital (CMCH) yesterday called off their indefinite strike after being assured that culprits who hacked one of their fellows would be arrested.

Rashedur Reza Sunny, president of Internee doctors Association (IDA) of CMCH, said they called off their strike, which began on Saturday, as the hospital authorities assured them that the main culprits would be arrested within 72 hours.

All hospital gates were opened at about 2:15pm yesterday after the strike was called off. However, by that time the visiting hour for outdoor patients was over.

Meanwhile, senior physicians of Chittagong said patients should not have had to suffer for an issue that is not an internal matter of the hospital.

Prof Dr Emran Bin Yunus, former principal of Chittagong Medical College, said as the incident occurred outside the hospital campus and was not directly related to professional issues, the interns' strike at the hospital was not appropriate since it caused immense sufferings to indoor and outdoor patients.

On Saturday, a group of miscreants hacked Sohail Parvez Suman, an intern CMCH and also a former president of CMC unit of Bangladesh Chhatra League, at Mehediabag in Chittagong city.

Law needed to ensure right to food security

Says Law Commission chairman-in-charge

Though Bangladesh achieved self-sufficiency in food, a law must be introduced to ensure people's right to food security, said Law Commission Chairman-in-Charge Prof M Shah Alam yesterday.

"Despite self-sufficiency, it cannot be claimed that all citizens are getting enough to eat although they are constitutionally and as per the Universal Declaration of Human Rights provided a right to food.

"A law for the right to food security will uphold citizens' right to food by making sure that there is always enough food and that he or she is provided for," he told a seminar, "Environment and Food Sustainability".

Experts at the seminar organised by Poribesh Bachao Andolan in the capital's Jatiya Press Club stated that food security also included cultivating more land and less crops like tobacco and enhancing food quality.

IO did not back prosecution witnesses' statements

Quader Mollah's lawyer tells SC

Statements of two prosecution witnesses -- Syed Abdul Kaium and Khondaker Abul Ahsan -- before the International Crimes Tribunal-2 were not corroborated by the investigation officer (IO) regarding Abdul Quader Mollah's involvement in the murder of Abu Taleb in 1971, Abdur Razzaq, a lawyer for Mollah, told the Supreme Court yesterday.

Abu Taleb, journalist, litterateur and lawyer, was killed on March 29, 1971 in Mirpur's Jalladkhana area.

Abdur Razzaq was placing arguments on the seventh day of the Appellate Division's hearing on convicted Jamaat-e-Islami leader Quader Mollah's appeal seeking acquittal in the war crimes case.

The defence counsel argued that Khondaker Abul Ahsan, son of Abu Taleb, stated before the ICT-2 that he had heard one Abdul Halim, a non-Bangalee and the

then chief accountant of the daily Ittefaq, was a colleague of Abu Taleb.

According to Abul Ahsan's statement, Abdul Halim offered Taleb a lift from Shantinagar to Mirpur. But on the way Halim handed over Taleb to Mollah and his accomplices, Razzaq said.

Prosecution witness Syed Abdul Kaium told the tribunal that he heard from one Khalilur Rahman and Taleb's driver Nizam that Halim had handed over Taleb to Quader Mollah and some non-Bangalees, including Aktar Gunda and Hakka Gunda, to kill him (Taleb), Razzaq said.

However, the IO of the case has stated before the ICT-2 that Kaium did not tell him that Halim handed over Taleb to Quader Mollah, Aktar Gunda and Hakka Gunda to kill him (Taleb), Razzaq argued.

The ICT-2 on February 5 awarded life term imprisonment to Mollah. The apex court fixed today for further hearing on the case.

Surgeon sent to jail for negligence

A Chittagong Court yesterday sent a doctor of Chittagong Medical College Hospital to jail in a case filed for negligence in surgery.

The court of Chittagong Metropolitan Magistrate Nure Alam Bhuiyan passed the order after Dr Shurman Ali surrendered to the court seeking bail in the case yesterday, said Advocate Iftekher Saimul Chowdhury, lawyer for the complainant.

Delwara Begum filed the case with the court on January 28 accusing Dr Shurman and Dr GM Zakir Hossain, a doctor of a private clinic in Chittagong city, for negligence while operating on her son Amirul Islam.

Ruhul Amin, sub-inspector of Panchlaih Police Station and investigation officer of the case, submitted the charge sheet against the two surgeons on May 30.

According to the case statement, Amirul, 21, was admitted to a private medical clinic in Chittagong city on May 30 last year requiring a surgery for haemorrhoids. During the operation, Dr Shurman left a needle inside Amirul. Later, Dr Zakir again operated on Amirul but failed to recover the needle. The patient had the needle removed in India.

Police said Dr Zakir was out on bail.

CHITTORANJAN COTTON MILL AREA HC orders not to fill up water bodies

The High Court yesterday directed the authorities concerned not to change the natural character of water bodies and not to fill them up in Chittoranjani Cotton Mills area of Narayanganj for the next three months.

In response to a writ petition, the court also issued a rule asking the authorities concerned of the government and Chittoranjani Cotton Mills to explain in two weeks why the mill authorities' decision to fill up the water bodies should not be declared illegal.

The court also asked them to explain why they should not be directed to give responsibility to Narayanganj municipality for maintaining the water bodies.

The HC bench of Justice Mirza Hussain Haider and Justice Muhammad Khurshid Alam Sarkar came up with the order and rule after hearing a writ petition filed by Bangladesh Environment Lawyers' Association (Bela).

Petitioner's lawyer Iqbal Kabir Lytton told The Daily Star that Chittoranjani Cotton Mills authorities have issued a tender notice on May 15 for filling up two ponds and a wetland inside the mill area.

If the water bodies are filled up, the environment of the area will be damaged, he said.
