Members of the Geological Survey of Bangladesh (GSB) have found presence of iron ore and limestone in the samples collected during a survey at Mushidpur village in Hakimpurupazila.

"We have collected some samples. A decision for further exploration will be taken following a laboratory test of the samples," said Munirul Islam, an engineer of the drilling team.

The drilling was started on March 22 and it continued till June 2 this year.

The GSB engineers drilled about 2167ft and found presence of limestone at a depth of 1190ft. They found hematite, magnetite and limonite in between 1500 and 1888ft depth.

The thickness of the iron ore layer was up to 3ft while limestone layer was up to 1200 feet.
