# Jamaat-enforced hartal in 8 dists ends peacefully

Relaxed hartal in 3 Ctg districts

A half-day hartal enforced by Jamaat-e-Islami protesting the arrest of a party leader passed off almost peacefully in eight districts of Rajshahi division yesterday.

In a press release on Monday, the Islamist party called the strike from 6.00am to 2.00pm, following arrest of Professor Rafiqul Islam, a Majhlish-e-Shura member of central Jammat and former ameer of Chapainawabganj.

Police arrested Rafiqu from Belepukur area of Chapainawabganj town in the early hours of the day.

In Chapainawabganj, police chased a group of activists of Islami Chhatra Shibir, student wing of Jamaat, when they gathered in front of PTI at Shibtala in a bid to bring out a procession at about 6.30am.

The Jamaat-Shibir activists hurled a cocktail in PTI area of the town but it did not explode.

During the incident, members of Rapid Action Battalion (Rab) fired several rubber bullets in the air and recovered the cocktail.

Most of the shops remained closed in the town and almost all modes of

vehicles except for battery-run easy-bike and CNG-run auto-rickshaws stayed off the streets for a couple of hours.

In Natore, Jamaat-Shibir activists brought out a procession in Chakrampur and Harishpur areas of the district town in the morning.

Police dispersed them when they blocked the Natore-Dhaka Highway by staging a sit-in in front of Sher-e-Bangla School.

In Bogra, police and pickets clashed at Dhunat intersection of Sherpur municipality in the morning.

Police said pro-hartal activists tried to block the Bogra-Sherpur highway. They threw brick-bats and vandalised several vehicles on the highway.

When police rushed to the spot, pickets charged brick-chips also on them, triggering a clash.

Sub-inspector Golam Mostafa and activist Abdul Barik, 52, were injured in the clash and at least four picket were arrested from the spot.

The arrestees are Shajahan Ali, 50, Abdur Rahman, 60, Siraj, 50, and injured picket Abdul Barik, 52, of the upazila.

The shutdown in other districts -- Rajshahi, Sirajganj, Pabna, Naogaon and Joypurhat -- was also observed in a relaxed way.

Meanwhile, a half-day hartal enforced by Islami Chhatra Shibir in Chittagong (south), Chandanaish, Satkania and Lohagara -- of Chittagong (south) which were under the purview of the shutdown.

No violent incident was reported from any of the seven upazilas--Boalkhali, Banskhali, Potiya, Anwara, Chandanaish, Satkania and Lohagara -- of Chittagong (south) which were under the purview of the shutdown.

No long-route bus left the port city for Cox's Bazar and Bandarban during the hartal hours.

There were no reports of violence also from anywhere in Bandarban and Cox's Bazar.

During hartal hours, vehicular movement and business activities were normal, but no long-route bus left the districts.

On Monday, Islami Chhatra Shibir, student wing of Jamaat-e-Islami, called the half-day hartal, protesting the arrest of Shibir unit president M Tarique Hossain from his city residence.

# Stalkers threaten to kill photojournalist

A freelance photojournalist faces death threat from a gang of stalkers for not withdrawing a case he filed against them with Sadar Police Station.

The stalkers assaulted photojournalist Helal Hossain Kabir, 24, of Mokra Dhadogachh village in Sadar upazila as he snapped them while stalking a girl at the village in December last year.

Critically injured Helal was under treatment at Rangpur Medical College Hospital and released in the second week of May. He filed the case with the police Station on May 19, accusing one Mizan Miah, 23, of the village and five others.

Police arrested Mizan the following day while the rest are still at large. The photojournalist filed a complaint with Sadar Police Station on Monday, stating that his life

is under threat by the accused.

Contacted, Sub-Inspector Quamrul Hasan, also the investigation officer (IO) of the case, said Mizan disclosed the names of the remaining five accused while he was on remand. He declined to give further details, saying that law enforcers are trying to arrest the culprits.

# Fake kabiraj, 2 aides jailed for 10 years

A court here on Monday sentenced a fake kabiraj (herbal medicine practitioner) and his two accomplices to 10 years' imprisonment each for their wrong treatment that left a patient dead.

The convicts are Md Billal Hossain of Purbo Pathangargh village in Chhagalnaiya upazila and accomplices Md Nur Nabi and Md Nasir Uddin of the upazila.

The court also fined the trio Tk 10,000 each, in default, to suffer three months more in jail.

District Additional Sessions Judge Muhammad Harun-ur-Rashid gave the verdict in presence of Billal

in the crowded courtroom while Nabi and Nasir remained at large.

According to the prosecution, on condition of Tk 15,000 to be paid by the family members, Billal took the responsibility of treating mentally challenged Zakir Hossain, 40, son of Tofazzal Hossain of the area.

Later, Billal along with Nabi and Nasir treated Zakir for six days since December 7, 2005. During this period, they dunked him repeatedly in pond with his hands and legs tied up.

At one stage, Zakir fell unconscious and later died. Zakir's brother Foyez Ullah then filed a murder case with Phulgazi police station, accusing the trio.

### UP chairman sent to jail

A court here on Monday sent a UP chairman to jail rejecting his bail prayer in a case filed on charge of misappropriation of foodgrains under Vulnerable Group Development (VGD) programme. The accused is Abdul Jalil, chairman of Gotamari union parishad in Hatibandha upazila. Police said, the UP chairman misappropriated 160Kgs wheat under the programme in the name of one Sandhya Rani, 55, of Dakhkhin Gotamari village, who died on 28 June, 2011 before preparing the beneficiary list. On May 21 last year, Monabberul Haque, a villager, filed a case with the Chief Judicial Magistrate court against chairman Jalil in connection with the incident.

### Boy jailed for stalking

A schoolboy was yesterday sentenced to two years' imprisonment for stalking a college girl in Ghatail upazila. The convict, Mohammad Rony, 17, is a class X student of Nozibuddin High School in the upazila. Mahbubul Haque, officer-in-charge (investigation) of Ghatail Police Station, said the boy teased the student of Brammanshasan Women's College in front of the institution in the morning. On receiving the news, teachers of the college with the help of locals caught the boy and informed the upazila nirbahi officer (UNO). The UNO, also the executive magistrate, went to the college and punished the boy on the basis of witnesses' statements.

### Man gets life for murder

A Sirajganj court yesterday sentenced a man to life imprisonment for killing a boy in Tarash upazila of the district 12 years ago. The convict is Alam Hossain, 32, son of Azgar Ali of Katgari village in the upazila. He was tried in absentia, court sources said. According to the prosecution, Md Kamal Hossain, 7, son of Ramzan Ali of Katgari village went missing on May, 25, 2000. His body was found floating on the Gumani River in Chatmohar upazila of the district the following day. Victim's father filed a case, naming none as accused. After investigation, police pressed charges against Alam Hossain. After examining records and witnesses, Additional District and Session Judge Umme Kulsum pronounced the verdict.

### Students block road

Students of Tangail Polytechnic Institute put up a barricade on Dhaka-Tangail Highway and vandalised vehicles after a teacher of the institute was injured in an accident on the road on Monday night. A banana-laden truck hit Bimal Biswas in Rabna bypass area in Sadar upazila at around 7:00pm, leaving him seriously injured. Hearing the news, students of the institute blocked the highway at Rabna point for an hour from 7:00pm. They also vandalised at the 40 vehicles on the busy road. The injured teacher was admitted to Tangail General Hospital.

# Bandarban villagers protest plan to acquire land

Indigenous people of three villages in Ruma upazilla formed a human chain and held a rally in the town yesterday, demanding cancellation of BGB's plan to acquire 25 acres of land in Paindu mouza and Poli mouza areas.

They also urged the government to exempt the villages where around 500

Marma families live.

At the rally, the speakers said scores of people of the villages will become totally landless if the plan of Border Guard Bangladesh (BGB) to acquire the lands is implemented.

Among others, Gong Bache Marma, a union parishad member, headman Mong Bau Marma, Mi Aung Prue Marma and Kaisa Aong Marma, spoke.

Later, they submitted a memorandum to the prime minister through upazilla nirbahi officer Mohammad Marufur Rashid Khan in favour of the demand.

Shafiz Ahasan, sector commander of BGB, Bandarban, said acquisition of land was under process to build BGB battalion headquarters in the two mouzas as no people reside in the areas.

# Probe mason Khaleque's death in custody, demand protesters

Construction workers brought out a procession in the town yesterday, demanding proper investigation into the death of an under trial prisoner, in the district jail on Monday.

Prisoner abdul Khaleque was a mason by profession.

The workers also submitted a memorandum to the deputy commissioner and superintendent of police in this regard.

Meanwhile, the leaders of the district workers' federation also came up with the same demand at a press conference in the town.

Among others, chief adviser of the federation Abdus Sabur Bir Bikram, general secretary of district truck workers' association Bala Miah and general secretary of district construction workers' association, were present.

On May 30 this year, sub-

inspector Anisur Rahman of Santosh Police outpost arrested mason Abdul Khaleque, 50, in a robbery case. He was then produced before a court which sent him to jail on Sunday.

Khaleque took his life by hanging himself from a pipe of the jail toilet early Monday, said the jail superintendent Abu Mohammad Fattah.

However, family members alleged that Khaleque died due to torture by police and no case was filed against him with any police station in the district.

Following the incident, district construction workers' association went on an indefinite strike, protesting the death of Khaleque.

# TRANSPORT WORKERS PROTEST ATTACK No buses left Rangpur for Dhaka due to strike

Transport workers of the city went on an indefinite strike on Dhaka route yesterday, protesting attack on fellow workers.

They also demanded immediate arrest of a word councilor of city corporation.

Due to the strike, no buses left for the capital city, causing immense sufferings to the passengers.

Police and locals said, Shafiu Karim Shafi, coun-

cillor of word No 15 of Rangpur City Corporation (RCC) and former president of Rangpur Carmichael College unit Chhatra Shibir locked in an altercation with Abdul Quddus, driver of Rangpur-bound 'TR Travels' from Dhaka and Abdul Latif, supervisor of the bus, over fare in the city on Monday night.

At one stage, Shafi and his associates assaulted Abdul Quddus and Abdul Latif, leaving them injured.

Following the incident, MA Mazid, general secre-

tary of Rangpur district transport workers' union, called the strike at an emergency meeting in the city yesterday morning, demanding immediate arrest and punishment of the attackers.

A case was filed accusing Shafi in connection with the attack, said Md Shahabuddin Khalifa, officer in-charge of Rangpur Kotwali police station.

Contacted, Shafi refused to say anything about the matter.
