

5 to die, 3 get life in Boral murder case

A Bagerhat court yesterday sentenced five people to death and three others to life imprisonment in Awami League leader advocate Kalidas Boral murder case.

Those who have been awarded death penalty are Md Alamgir Siddiky and his brother Nasir Siddiky of Rahmatpur village, Saidul Islam alias Sayeed Fakir of Borobarria village, Saifur Rahman alias Babul Gazi of Ghola village, and Swapan of Kalatala village under Chitalmari upazila of the district.

Of the five, Alamgir Siddiky is now in jail while the rest four are absconding.

The lifers are Swakat Siddiky of Rahmatpur village in Chitalmari upazila, Babul Mollah of Chargaon village, and Manik of Sultanpur village in Sadar upazila. The court fined them Tk 20,000 each, in

default they are to suffer another two years in jail.

District and Sessions judge SM Solaiman pronounced the verdict in the case at noon. He also acquitted nine other accused as prosecution could not prove

murder charges against them.

Chitalmari upazila Awami League leader and former chairman of the upazila parishad advocate Kalidas Boral was shot dead

by a gang at Sadhana intersection in the district town on August 20, 2000.

Boral was also the president Bagerhat district puja udjapan parishad and a central leader of Bangladesh Hindu-Bouddha-Christian Oikya Parishad.

Happy Boral, wife of the slain leader, filed a case with Bagerhat Model Police Station on the following day, accusing five identified and some unidentified people.

After investigation, the then officer-in-charge (OC) Shahidul Islam of the police station pressed charges against 22 people on October 31 of the same year. Five of the accused died during the trial of the case. The court recorded the statements of 42 witnesses.

Happy Boral expressed dissatisfaction with the verdict. She told journalists on the court premises that she would go to the higher court.

5 held with gecko in Gopalganj

Police arrested five people along with a gecko, a rare lizard type reptile, on Dhaka-Gopalganj Highway in Kasiani upazila of the district early Tuesday.

The arrestees were identified as Ripon Biswas, 24, Kabir Hossain, 25, Ratin Biswas, 26, Tarun Sarnokar, 26, and Manik Biswas, 35 -- all members of a smuggling gang.

Belayet Hossain, Inspector at Kasiani PS said, acting on a

tip-off, a team of the highway police intercepted a car carrying the aforesaid men at Bhatiyapara bus stand on the highway around 3:30am and seized a gecko, locally known as Takshak, from their possession.

Belayet Hossain said the gang had been doing various types of illegal business besides gecko smuggling for a long time.

The weight of the rescued gecko was 50 gram and length 6-7 inches.

Four electrocuted

The deceased were identified as house owner Sree Ujjal Chandra Sarker, 28, son of Nikhil Chandra Sarker, his wife Sabitri Rani, 23, of Sirajnagar village and worker

Shuski Mahato, 25, son of Mongla Mahato of Tarash upazila in Sirajganj district.

Away in Jamalpur, a housewife was electrocuted at Thakurpara village in Bakshiganj upazila on Tuesday night, reports our correspondent.

The deceased was identified as Rabeya, 20, wife of Ershad Ali of the village.

Erosion renders 250 families homeless

Erosion by the Teesta and Dharla rivers rendered at least 250 families in three upazilas homeless in the last three days.

The erosion-hit people of 20 villages have now taken shelter on the dyke of Water Development Board (WDB) in the district, said an official of WDB.

Teesta took a serious turn on Monday, devouring a number of homesteads and vast croplands at Kalmati village in Sadar upazila.

"My homestead was eroded by Teesta on Tuesday morning" said Abdar

Hossain of Gokunda village in Sadar upazila.

Another victim Mobarok Ali of Chawratari village in the upazila said, more than 25 families in the area were rendered homeless by the River Dharla erosion during the period.

Executive engineer of Lalmonirhat WDB Enayet Ullah said, the rivers devoured scores of homesteads, vast farmlands and orchards since Monday till yesterday.

We have already written to the higher authorities for funds to take immediate steps to check the erosion, he said.

Abducted girl yet to be rescued

A teenage girl abducted by stalkers a week ago is yet to be rescued by police.

Family sources and locals said a few youths abducted the girl on her way back home from a coaching centre at village Bolderdiar in Doail union under Sarishabari upazila of the district on May 30 evening.

The girl was a class-eight student at Chaperkona Moheshchandra High School under the upazila and resident of village Dolbhiti under the same union.

Father of the girl filed an abduction case with Sarishabari police station against two siblings -- Ariful

and Shariful -- sons of Fazlul Haque and their accomplice Fazlu of Bolderdiar village the next day.

Locals said the girl used to attend the coaching centre at Madhur More in Bolderdiar village regularly. Ariful, Shariful and Fazlu often stalked her on the way back home.

On May 30, the stalkers picked up the girl forcibly at around 7.00pm and took her to an unknown place, said the complaint.

Contacted, Investigation Officer of the case Aslam Uddin, inspector (investigation) of the police station said they were carrying out drives to arrest the accused.

"We could not arrest anybody as all of them went into hiding", he said.

Dredging of Kaliganga River demanded

Human chain in Manikganj

Different social and cultural organisations brought out a procession and formed a human chain in the district town yesterday, demanding dredging of Kaliganga River.

They brought out the procession at around 10:00am and paraded the main streets of the town. Later, they formed the human chain in front of Manikganj Press Club at around 10:30am.

Hundreds of people including politicians, journalists, lawyers, students, teachers and NGO personalities joined the programmes.

(BARCIK) Bimal Roy, CPB leader Arshed Ali Master and BARCIK official Nazul Islam addressed the human chain programme.

They said the Kaliganga River was dying due to non-stop dumping of toxic waste by the industries near the river. The farmers face serious problem as they do not get water for farming because of siltation. They urged the authorities concerned to take an urgent decision in favour of dredging the river.

The organisations arranged the programmes to mark the World Environment Day.

The district administration and Environment office jointly brought out a colourful procession and held a discussion to observe the day.

The day was also observed in other districts yesterday demanding measures to maintain ecological balance, report our correspondents.

Saturia traders demand bridge linking market

Traders of Saturia Bazar under Saturia upazila of the district yesterday demanded construction of a bridge over Gazikhali River and a road connecting the bridge and the bazar.
