## Police arrest twelve criminals in capital

Police arrested 12 people on charges of illegal firearm trading, carjacking, mugging and drug peddling and recovered 10 firearms and 61 bullets from their possession in separate drives in different parts of the capital on Monday night and early yesterday.

According to the Detective Branch (DB) of Police, the arrestees told them that more gangs are active in firearms trafficking in the city ahead of the parliamentary polls.

The detectives added that several DB teams have been trying to arrest the firearms traders.

At a press briefing in Dhaka Metropolitan Police Media Centre yesterday, DMP Joint Commissioner Monirul Islam told reporters that a team of detectives arrested firearms traders Kamal Hossain alias Double Silencer Kamal, 37, and Kabir Hossain, 38, in Siddique Bazar of Bangshal on Monday night.

The detectives recovered two revolvers, a foreign pistol and 24 bullets from them.

Following information provided by the arrestees, the DB team carried out a raid in Dholaikhal area and arrested Israfil, 40, Shahrukh Talukder, 42, and Shamsul Alam alias Shimul, 35, and recovered a pistol, 18 bullets and a magazine from their possession.

"The arrestees used to collect firearms and supply those to criminals with political affiliations in and outside the capital," Monirul said.

The detectives suspected that the arms might be used to create anarchy before the general polls.

Rejecting the alleged relation between firearms traders and law enforcers, Monirul said, "We need to arrest law enforcers with firearms as evidence to take action against them."

In another drive in Mohammadpur area, DB police arrested carjackers Md Shamim, 30, Suman Chowdhury, 35, Masud Rana alias Alam, 32, and Ariful Islam and recovered a pistol, four bullets and two machetes from them.

Combining the Basabo Railway Workshop area early yesterday, detectives arrested two muggers -- Kamal Rasel and Millu Rasel -- with three pistols, a shutter gun and nine bullets and a machete.

Another DB team arrested a female drug dealer, Farjana Aktar, 25, with a foreign pistol and four bullets from West Rampura on Monday evening. Five cases were filed.

## New envoy to Nepal presents credentials

The newly appointed Bangladesh Ambassador to Nepal Mashfee Binte Shams presented her credentials to Nepal President Ram Baran Yadav yesterday.

The Bangladesh envoy recalled the traditional and historical linkages between the two countries at a programme arranged on the occasion at the Sheetal Nivaas (the presidential palace of Nepal).

She also conveyed the desire of the government of Bangladesh to strengthen and deepen bilateral relations between the two countries.

President Ram Baran Yadav recalled with gratitude the Friends of Bangladesh Award conferred on him by the Bangladesh government for his contribution to the independence of Bangladesh in 1971.

He referred to the various areas of bilateral cooperation, including trade and commerce, cultural exchange, and people-to-people contacts, between the two countries.

The president hoped that the two countries would be able to harness the potential for mutual benefit.

He also conveyed his warm greetings to the president, prime minister and the people of Bangladesh.

## Peruvian held with 'drugs' in capital

A team of the Department of Narcotics Control yesterday seized a consignment of about 3.5kg of material, preliminarily detected as heroin or cocaine, and arrested a Peruvian in Hotel La Vinci in the capital.

Juan Pablo Rafael, 28, was caught with three packs of expensive drugs when the DNC team raided his room around 8:00pm.

"On secret information, we knew that a foreigner was coming to Bangladesh with a large amount of drugs. We knew which flight he took, but he had left the terminal before we reached there," said Shamsul Amin, additional director (intelligence), DNC.

Six DNC teams had looked for him at different hotels before they found him, he added.

## Protection for child domestic helps sought

Although Bangladesh, like other countries, will observe World Day Against Child Labour today under the theme "No to child labour in domestic work", its labour law does not recognise child domestic workers as labourers, said speakers yesterday.

Not even the labour ministry's list of hazardous work for children includes domestic child labour, they said.

They were addressing a press briefing at Jatiya Press Club organised by the Ministry of Labour and Employment in association with Manusher Jonno Foundation, ILO, Save the Children and

Shishu Adhikar Forum.

Stating that domestic child workers are often tortured by their employers, Shaheen Anam, executive director of Manusher Jonno Foundation, said journalists should find out what happens to the cases that are filed against those employers.

Md Mujibur Rahman, joint secretary of the labour ministry, said a set of programmes, including a national seminar, rallies and awareness campaigns, will be held to observe the day across the country today. "The government is aiming to get rid of the most hazardous forms of child labour from the country by 2016," he said.

## Govt to contribute \$50,000 for Al-Quds, Al-Sharif development

Foreign Minister Dipu Moni yesterday pledged a token contribution of US\$ 50,000 from the Bangladeshi government to finance the Strategic Plan for Development of Al-Quds and Al-Sharif of Palestine.

The foreign minister made this announcement during her participation in the OIC Foreign Ministers' "Donor Conference on Strategic Plan for Development of Al-Quds and Al-Sharif" and "Conference on Establishing an Islamic Financial Safety Net in support of the State of Palestine" held in Azerbaijan.

In her statement, she reiterated Bangladesh's unstinting support for a fully sovereign Palestinian state within the pre-1967 borders with Al-Quds (East Jerusalem) as its capital, said a press release.


The 12th OIC Summit held in Egypt on February 6 and 7, 2013 had adopted the Strategic Plan for Development of Al-Quds and Al-Sharif which anticipates development of 12 sectors in the occupied East Jerusalem and called for a donor conference to finance implementation of the plan.
