Rana's 4 associates on 4-day remand

A Dhaka court sent four more persons, who allegedly forced garment workers to join their work despite cracks were found in the Rana Plaza, on a four-day remand yesterday.

They are Abdul Mannan, 37, Md Alamgir Hossain, 30, Mohammad Modhu, 27, and Md Russel Ahmed, 31.

Police said the people are associates of Sohail Rana, owner of Rana Plaza.

The court passed the order after the Criminal Investigation Department (CID) of Police produced them before it with a seven-day remand prayer.

Earlier on Tuesday night, police arrested the persons from different places in Savar in connection with the April 24 collapse that claimed 1,131 lives.

Bijoy Krishna Kar, assistant superintendent of police, told the court that Rana Plaza's owner Sohail Rana and the four forced the garments workers to work on the 2nd floor of the nine-storey building despite the cracks developed in its pillars on the previous day of the collapse. So, they need to be remanded for the sake of investigation.

During the hearing, Abdul Mannan told the court that his residence is near the Rana Plaza. He went to the spot soon after the collapse of the building and joined the rescue efforts. He rescued six injured garment workers alive.

However, the rest three did not say anything during the hearing.

Earlier on June 10, four owners of the Rana Plaza factories were remanded for two days. They are Anisur Rahman, Aminul Islam, Bazlul Samad Adnan and Mahbubur Rahman Tapash. Police have so far arrested 15 people in connection with the incident.

Verdict on Jamaat's registration soon

The High Court will deliver its verdict any day regarding a writ petition that challenged the legality of Jamaat-e-Islami's registration as a political party.

After concluding hearing arguments from the counsels on the petition, the HC yesterday kept it waiting for delivering verdict.

A special HC bench of Justice M Moazzam Husain and Justice Quazi Reza-Ul Hoque started hearing on the matter on April 11.

On January 25, 2009, Bangladesh Tarikat Federation's Secretary General Rezaul Haque Chandpuri and 24 others filed the writ petition saying that Jamaat is a religion-based political party and it does not believe in independence and sovereignty of Bangladesh.

On November 14, 2008, the Election Commission listed Jamaat as a registered political party in violation of the Constitution and the spirit of the Representation of People Order (RPO) Ordinance, 2008, they said.

On January 27, 2009, the HC had issued the rule asking Jamaat's chief and its secretary general; and the EC to explain why the party's registration should not be declared illegal.

In reply to the HC rule, the EC told it that some provisions of Jamaat's charter are against the country's constitution and RPO, while Jamaat said the EC had not done any illegality by registering the party.

Barrister Tania Amir appeared for the writ petitioners, while Barrister Abdur Razzaq argued for Jamaat and Advocate Mohsen Rashid and Additional Attorney General MK Rahman represented EC.

TRIAL OF TOKI'S KILLERS

20 citizens seek PM's intervention

Twenty eminent personalities of the country yesterday sought prime minister's intervention in the speedy trial of the killers of Tanvir Mohammad Toki.

Teenager Toki went missing on March 6. He was found dead on the bank of Shitalakkhya river in Narayanganj two days later.

Three months had already been elapsed since the murder, they said in a statement, but no headway in the investigation had so far been made.

It added that the investigation into the murder case had apparently stopped.

Stop to employing children as domestic helps urged

Hundreds of disadvantaged children at a programme in the capital yesterday urged society to stop employing children as domestic helps.

Meanwhile, a Chittagong seminar, "Situation Analysis of the Working Children in Transport Sector (Tempo) in Chittagong", organised by Ghasful, an NGO, informed that nearly 700 children were at risk for working as human hauler helpers in the city.

Non-government organisations (NGO) Sohay, Vafud, Aparajeyo Bangladesh and Community Participation and Development, supported by Manusher Jonno Foundation, organised the capital's programme in the Institution of Engineers, Bangladesh.

The programme marked World Day Against Child Labour, themed "No to Child Labour in Domestic Work" this year by the labour and employment ministry.

"Employing children as domestic helps

often inhibits them from getting better chances in life," said Additional Secretary to the NGO Affairs Bureau Mohammad Nurun Nabi Talukder.

The financially insolvent constitute the population's 31 percent and their condition cannot be improved without children's development, he said.

"It is inevitable that many children born in deprived conditions will become engaged in child labour. However, they should be kept out of hazardous works," said Manusher Jonno Foundation Executive Director Shaheen Anam.

Many of the children present yesterday were engaged in underage, often hazardous, labour, but are now enrolled in schools or in capacity building and vocational training programmes with the help of the four NGOs.

They took part in different events at yesterday's programme and demanded that underage domestic workers be given the same opportunities they were provided.
