JBPH giving free treatment to 4 Rana Plaza survivors

At a press conference at the hospital yesterday, JBPH administration also informed that there were many other survivors of the tragedy who did not receive complete treatment. "Many of the injured will be able to work again if they are given adequate care," said JBPH Chairman Md Jonaid Shafiq.

The election was held at the Bangladesh Institute of Health Science in the capital on Tuesday. BPA's new website www.bd-bpa.org was also launched at the event.



CTG ARMS HAUL CASES
Cross-examination of IO deferred

The cross examination of the last investigation officer (IO) of the Chittagong 10-truck arms haul cases, who could not attend court due to illness yesterday, was deferred till July 1.

Prosecution lawyer Kamal Uddin Ahmad appealed to Chittagong Metropolitan Special Tribunal-1 for time, saying the investigator Md Moniruzzaman had been cross-examined for the last 11 scheduled days, and he felt sick during cross-examination on Wednesday.

The court fixed three days from July 1 for resuming the cross-examination. Defence lawyers started cross-examining Moniruzzaman, an additional superintendent of police of the Criminal Investigation Department (CID), on May 6.

Moniruzzaman was appointed the fifth IO of both arms and smuggling cases in connection with the sensational arms haul, which took place on April 2, 2004.

HEFAJAT CLASH WITH COPS
BNP leader Taimur among 17 getting bail

A Narayanganj court yesterday granted bail for one month to BNP leader Taimur Alam Khandoker and 16 others in two cases filed over the clash between activists of Hefajat-e Islam and law enforcers on May 6.

Additional District and Session's Judges Court Judge Ali Akber passed the order after a bail petition filed by the people before it.

Yesterday, they appeared before the court following an order of the High Court.

Earlier on May 19, the HC granted them one month interim bail.

Police filed the cases with Shiddirganj and Sonargaon Police Stations after the clash that left at least 19 people, including two border guard members and two policemen, dead in Shiddirganj and Kanchpur areas of the district.

Contacted, Taimur Alam, president of Narayanganj district unit of BNP, said BNP leaders and activists were implicated in the cases, although they were not involved in the incident.

BURIAL OF FREEDOM FIGHTER
Narail OC faces HC for not giving state honour

The High Court yesterday summoned Noragati police officer-in-charge in Narail to appear before it on July 9 for not giving state honour to a freedom fighter during his burial.

The court passed the order on a suo moto move following a Bangla daily report headlined "Rastriya morjada chharai muktijoddha dafon (Freedom fighter buried without state honour)" published on Wednesday.

The report said Moyen Uddin, 65, of Nolmara under the police station died on June 10. Locals informed the police of the death.

The police did not initiate to give state honour to him, but told the locals that OC Amir Taimur Ilee was busy with playing carom, it added.

PM warns police of zero tolerance for indiscipline

Stressing the importance of maintaining departmental discipline, Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina yesterday warned the police that no one will be spared if found guilty as the government has adopted a "zero tolerance" policy to indiscipline.

"We have adopted a zero tolerance policy to departmental indiscipline. No one will be spared if found guilty," she said addressing the passing out ceremony of the 30th batch of assistant superintendents of police (ASPs) at the Sardah Police Academy.

Mentioning that it was the sacred duty of the police force to always serve people, the prime minister asked them to provide better services to the mass people. "People come to you for shelter. You should stand like friends beside those in danger. You also

need to be on maximum alert so that women and children are not neglected in any way," she said.

She asked the members of the police force to be more active and dynamic in combating crimes in the perspective of changed offence techniques.

"You will have to use modern technologies to combat crimes like international and regional terrorism and militancy, cybercrimes and money laundering. Each member of the police force has to be skilled in information technology. One has to attain international standard to detect crimes and criminals," she said.

Home Minister Dr Muhimuddin Khan Alamgir and State Minister for Home Shamsul Haque Tuku were present among others.
