Zarrar Rahman, 7, is suffering from a brain tumour, which is already in its critical stage. Doctors recommended that Zarrar should be immediately provided better treatment which is very costly and his father, a manager of a buying house in Shantou, China, cannot afford the expenses.

## Tanker with furnace oil seized in Ctg

A team of Bangladesh Coastguard yesterday seized an oil tanker carrying furnace oil worth about Tk 1.72 crore without valid documents from the river Karnaphuli in Chittagong yesterday.

The tanker - New OT Samrat - was carrying 201,500 litres of furnace oil at around 11:00am, said Lt Commander Atiqur Rahman.

On searching the oil tanker, the coast-

guard team did not find related documents for the furnace oil and thus seized the ship and the furnace oil, he said.

The ship might have illegally procured the furnace oil from the merchant vessels anchored in the outer anchorage of Chittagong Port, he added.

"We will keep the tanker in our custody for the time being," said Atiqur, adding that they will sit with customs officials today to settle the matter.

## BB to monitor online forex transactions

The Bangladesh Bank will monitor online all foreign exchange transactions through banking channel with their "Foreign Exchange Transactions Monitoring Dashboard", which will record data on forex transactions round the clock.

"Foreign exchange transactions are now under our close monitoring as the Foreign Exchange Dashboard shows data about such transactions round the clock," said Deputy Governor Nazneen Sultana, adding that the BB is now fully capable of taking immediate steps after detecting any irregularity.

The Fx Dashboard is a graphic presentation of four online reporting modules for monitoring the foreign exchange transactions of the authorised dealer (AD) branches of the country. The modules are Online Export Monitoring System, Online Import Monitoring System, Online Outward Remittance Monitoring System and Online Inward and Wage Earner's Remittance Monitoring System.

The BB has developed the software of these four modules and Fx Dashboard with its own efforts and technology, said Nazneen Sultana, who looks after the BB's IT Operation and Communication Department.

She said all departments concerned, including Foreign Exchange Operation Department, Foreign Exchange Policy Department, Foreign Exchange Inspection Department, Financial Integrity and Customer Services Department, are now capable of monitoring and supervising forex transactions reported directly by all AD branches of banks across the country.

"Not only the departments concerned of the central bank, we have given the top officials of all commercial banks the user ID and password to monitor and supervise the forex dealings of their respective banks," added Nazneen Sultana.

"Even the governor can watch and supervise every minute's update of forex transactions," she added.

## EVICTION OF 14 CHAK FAMILIES IN BANDARBAR

## NHRC claims steps were already taken

The National Human Rights Commission (NHRC) in a statement on Thursday said it has already asked the authorities concerned to take necessary steps to rehabilitate 14 families of Chak community to their ancestral home at Badurjhiri of Naikhyangchhari in Bandarban.

On March 15, land grabbers evicted the families with repeated death threats from their homes at Chak Para.

The NHRC's statement came after United National Awami Party President Pankaj Bhattacharya at a press conference in the capital on June 19 demanded resignation of NHRC's chairman for his inaction in this regard. Earlier, Pankaj led a civic delegation during its visit to the crime spot.

In the statement, the NHRC said the Chittagong Hill Tracts (CHT) Affairs Ministry formed a probe committee and it made 10 recommendations, including arresting the land grabbers, rehabilitating the evicted families on their own lands and demarcating the lands of Bangalees.

The NHRC has sent the report to Bandarban deputy commissioner and the superintendent of police for necessary action, it added.

## Iron rod-laden truck looted

The relative said they were carrying the rods from a factory of Meghna Ghat to the capital's Tejgaon.

Askir, quoting his cousin Kamrul, told The Daily Star that the criminals stopped the truck as one of its tyre got flat.
