



Jahanara Imam's 19th death anniversary today

Today is the 19th death anniversary of Shaheed Janani Jahanara Imam. Different political and socio-cultural organisations will observe the day with an array of programmes. On this day in 1994, Jahanara died of cancer in Michigan, US at the age of 65. She was born in Murshidabad district of West Bengal on May 3, 1929.

In a message, Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina said she believed that proper respect would be shown to Jahanara by completing the trial of the war criminals. Ekattorer Ghatok Dalal Nirmul Committee, a platform formed in 1992 by Jahanara to raise voice for the trial of the war criminals, will hold an event in the WVA auditorium at the capital's Dhanmondi. The programme will include Jahanara Imam Memorial Lecture, a discussion, and the handing over of an award named after her. Eminent legal expert Barrister M Amir-ul-Islam and Justice ABM Khairul Haque will receive the award as individuals, while Gonojagoron Mancha, a platform of youths demanding the highest punishment for the war criminals, will be awarded as an organisation. Jahanara Imam's family was directly involved in the Liberation War of 1971.

Hiron's PS enters BCC building 'forcefully'

Takes away some files

A personal secretary to immediate past mayor of Barisal City Corporation (BCC) Shawkat Hossain Hiron allegedly removed some documents from Barisal Nagar Bhaban after assaulting night guards and entering the building by force early yesterday. The guards -- Malek Fakir, Rafikul Islam and Md Faruk, said Hiron's personal secretary Md Alimullah came to the Bhaban around 12:10am and asked them to open the gate. Although Alimullah was requested to come to the bhaban during office hours, he entered the building by force and came out with some documents and files, they alleged. Contacted, Alimullah, who is also an official of the local government ministry, denied the allegation of assaulting the night guards. He, however, admitted that he entered the BCC building to collect a seminar paper kept in his office. The seminar was scheduled to be held at Manikganj today, he added. Nikhil Chandra Das, chief executive officer of BCC, said usually no official files are kept under the custody of personal secretary to the mayor. "Alimullah informed me today that he went inside the nagar bhaban Monday night to collect his personal documents on his way home after performing prayers of Shab-e Barat at a nearby mosque, he said yesterday.

Road crashes kill 5, injure 7

Five people were killed and seven others injured in separate road accidents across the country on Monday and yesterday. Staff Correspondent reports, a teenager was killed and two others were injured when a speedy passenger bus hit the rickshaw van carrying them on the capital's Khilgaon flyover early yesterday. The deceased, Mohammad Raihan, 16, was an employee of a tailor shop at Kadamtola. The injured are Alauddin, 17, and Raj, 17. They were admitted to Dhaka Medical College Hospital. Locals held the bus driver Mohammad Sohel, 24, and his helper Alauddin, 26, and handed them over to police. Our Mymensingh correspondent adds, a carpenter was killed when a Mymensingh-bound BRTC bus hit him while he was crossing the Mymensingh-Kishoreganj road at Gazipur in Gouripur upazila yesterday morning. The victim is Md Raisuddin, 20, of Panati village in Gouripur. Agitated locals blocked the road for an hour demanding immediate arrest of the driver. A case was lodged in this regard. Our Bogra correspondent adds, a person died after an oncoming Dhaka-bound bus

"Al-Hamra" hit his bicycle on Bogra-Dhaka highway at Aria Bazar in Noymail area of Shajahanpur upazila of Bogra yesterday. The deceased, Sergeant Jahid, 40, of Sadar upazila in Pirojpur, worked at Majhira Cantonment. Following the accident, agitated locals blocked the highway for two hours demanding speed breakers which caused a long tailback on the road. Shajahanpur police seized the bus from Dhunat intersection in Bogra. Our Pabna Correspondent adds, a passenger of a three-wheeler was killed and three others were injured when the vehicle skidded off the Pabna-Santhia highway and fell into a roadside ditch in Boailmari area on Monday morning. The deceased is Md Abdus Sattar, 45, of Shazadpur upazila. Our Gaibandha correspondent reports, a passenger of a three-wheeler was killed and five others were injured when the vehicle overturned and fell into a ditch beside Gobindaganj-Mohimaganj road at Amaner vita on Monday night. The deceased is Palash Shiekh, 18, of Gobindaganj upazila, Two of the injured, Abdur Razzak and Abdul Wahed, were admitted to Gobindaganj health complex.

Bangladesh seeks more cooperation from IMO

Bangladesh has called for greater support from International Maritime Organization (IMO) for capacity building of marine institutions in the country. Foreign Minister Dipu Moni made the call when visiting IMO Secretary General Koji Sekimizu called on her at Bangladesh Parliament yesterday, said a press release. During the meeting, the foreign minister thanked the secretary general for various technical assistance programmes undertaken by IMO in Bangladesh to improve of quality of maritime education and ensuring environmental protection, maritime safety and security. She sought IMO's help create more employment opportunities for Bangladeshi seafarers. Koji lauded Bangladesh for its achievements in becoming a new ship building destination. He also stressed the need for protection of environment in the industry for sustainable development of the sector. He requested Dipu Moni to consider ratifying the "Hong Kong International Convention for Safe and Environmentally Sound Recycling of Ships" to minimise health hazards and ensure safety to the environment. Sekimizu is on a four day visit to Bangladesh. During the visit, he will visit Chittagong Marine Academy, Sitakunda shipbuilding and ship recycling facilities and Narayanganj Inland Water Terminal and meet the industry leaders and stakeholders.

UK says Bangladesh is a pilot country

The UK, which is planning to run a pilot project from November, requiring financial bonds from selected visitors, yesterday said Bangladesh was being considered a pilot country, and no final decision had been made. Any scheme would only affect a small number of the highest risk visitors, said a statement of the British High Commission in Dhaka yesterday. Responding to reports that the UK government plans to trial the use of immigration bonds, the statement said, "The UK government has already announced its intention to trial the use of financial bonds as a way of tackling abuse in the immigration system. "The details of the policy are still being finalised. Bangladesh is being considered as a pilot country but no final decision has been made." Giving a background, the statement said other countries applied similar schemes to mitigate the risk of visitors overstaying their visa. For example, Australia and New Zealand set financial bonds at between 5,000 and 15,000 Australian dollars and 5,000 and 10,000 New Zealand dollars, it added.
