Roads, housing projects shrinking arable land

Views-exchange meeting told

Arable land is shrinking in the country due to construction of new roads and housing projects, posing a threat to the country's food security, speakers observed at a programme yesterday.

They were addressing a views-exchange meeting on the draft of National Agriculture Policy 2013. The programme titled "National Agriculture Conference 2013" was organised by INCIDIN Bangladesh and Manusher Jonno Foundation (MJF) at the LGED building in the capital.

Every year the area of cultivable land decreases by 0.1% as a result of construction of new and widening of old roads, said Agriculture Minister Matia Chowdhury.

Now arable land is often advertised through online platforms for sale, said Tofazzal Hossain Manju, convener of the National Agricultural Review Committee. He also suggested formulating a law for protecting cultivable lands.

Most pieces of land in the country are under private ownership which is why the government can hardly conduct any experiment on cultivation in those lands, said the agriculture minister.

She also stressed the need for adopting new technologies in agriculture instead of solely relying on obsolete methods. Lawmaker Shagufta Yasmin Emily and MJF Director (Rights) Rina Roy spoke among others.

SOUTH, SOUTH-WEST ASIA

Stronger transport connectivity urged to propel growth

Speakers at a dialogue yesterday called for strengthening transport connectivity among the south and south-west Asian countries to build long-term cooperation for economic development.

They said the south and south-west Asian region, which includes Iraq, Iran, Saudi Arabia, Turkey, Kuwait, and Syria among others, was less connected in the world and thus lagging behind despite immense potentials to achieve economic growth.

The UN Economic and Social Commission for Asia and the Pacific (UNESCAP) and the Bangladesh Institute of International and Strategic Studies (BIISS) organised the two-day policy dialogue, "Strengthening Transport Connectivity among the South and South-West Asian Countries", at the capital's Sonargaon Hotel.

Prime Minister's Economic Affairs Adviser Mashiur Rahman, who presented a keynote paper at the inaugural session, stressed making the joint communiqué and the framework agreement signed with India in September

2011 operational for the region's development.

He also recommended signing trilateral agreements having India as a common party to replace bilateral deals signed with Bhutan and Nepal for removing trade barriers. "The vision represents a new paradigm of foreign policy based on cooperation for national welfare and co-prosperity abandoning nervous isolation," he added.

PM's Defence Adviser Maj Gen (retd) Tarique Ahmed Siddique highlighted the issue of security as connectivity created the scope of mobility of terrorism. He said transportation security and mobility should get importance on the transit issues.

BIISS Chairman Munshi Faiz Ahmad BIISS Director General Maj Gen Sajjadul Haq, and UNESCAP Chief Economist Nagesh Kumar also spoke at the session.

In his paper, "Connectivity, Economic Welfare and Foreign Policy Paradigm", Mashiur also recommended simplifying and harmonising customs and immigration rules and procedures to enhance efficiency of transit and remove multiple checks and trans-shipments at each border.

Torture in cop custody should be criminalised

Say jurists, scholars

A group of prominent jurists and scholars at an event yesterday said torture in police custody should be criminalised in the Bangladeshi legislation for ensuring justice for victims.

They gave the view after listening to the experiences of relatives of a survivor and of two victims who died in police custody and of a survivor herself. They were addressing an event titled "People's

Tribunal", says a statement of the rights groups Odhikar and Asian Human Rights Commission. Odhikar in collaboration with the European Union organised the programme in the capital.

Among those who told stories of torture in police custody were brother of Shamim Reza, who died on May 22 after being tortured by Sonargaon police in Narayanganj; Moni Begum who survived torture in Sitakunda Police Station in Chittagong; and brother of Rizvi Hasan who was tortured in Chittagong Central Jail but survived.

Code of Criminal Procedure (CrPC). In a statement, Law Minister Shafique Ahmed said yesterday that rules for settling serious crimes through compromise outside court would not be incorporated into the amendments aimed at reducing the backlog of 27 lakh cases pend-

ing with different courts throughout the country. The serious offences include extortion, death threat for extortion, theft, bank fraud, torture for dowry, causing death by driving vehicles recklessly or by negligence, and assault in attempted murder.

Sources said the ministry had prepared the draft by adding 20 more offences to the existing 64 as crimes which can be settled outside court in the proposed changes.

The government has moved to amend the CrPC to include a provision for disposing of cases related to petty crimes through Alternative Dispute Resolution (ADR) system to reduce case backlog, eliminate harassment of litigants, and save their money and time.
