## PUST teachers demand punishment to culprits

BCL activists beat up JCD activist Md Jubayer Hossain of economics department of the university when he was attending a class conducted by Md Enamul Haque, teacher of the department, on Saturday.

The activists had assaulted Enamul Haque before they dragged Jubayer out of the class and beat him, university sources said.

Protesting the university authorities' 'negligence' about taking action against the perpetrators, teachers at an urgent meeting on Saturday decided to observe work abstention on Wednesday and Thursday.

"The teachers demanded taking action against the attackers but the authorities

threatens to suspend the teachers for making the demand," said a teacher seeking anonymity.

If the university authorities fail to take proper step by Thursday, tougher agitation will be taken, said another teacher.

Supporting the teachers' demand, JCD brought out a procession in Pabna Bus terminal area and moved towards the university campus but police prevented them.

"As we could not go to the campus we held a protest meeting in the terminal area," said SM Rafiuzzaman, an organiser of JCD.

Contacted, Md Mizanur Rahman Sabuj, president of PUST unit of BCL, said, "JCD men opened fire and hurled cocktails outside the university to create panic. BCL men chased them."



## BGB-BSF meet

Commander of the check post Abdul Mannan said the two sides discussed the issues like recent shootings, including the killing of two cattle traders on May 29 at Putkhali frontier and human trafficking. A five-member delegation team, headed by Lt Col Matiur Rahman, commander of BGB-26, led the team while BSF side was headed by Commander Dinesh Marma. Earlier on the day, Matiur Rahman welcomed the BSF team at the camp.

## Two electrocuted

Two people were electrocuted in two upazilas of the district yesterday. Family members said Babu Khandakar, 30, son of Shirajul Khandakar of Jogarpura village in Kahaloo upazila, died from electrocution while he came in contact with a live electric wire at their home. In Sherpur upazila, Golam Mostafa, 20, son of Chan Mia of Gopalpur village, was electrocuted at a local bazaar at 1:00pm on Wednesday. He was rushed to the upazila health complex where the attending doctors declared him dead, said police.

## 2 sued on rape charge

Two youths were sued on rape charge in Daulatpur upazila on Sunday. They are Mizanur Rahman, 21, son of Gendu Mia of Sametpur village and Helal Uddin, 22, son of Idris Uddin of Daulatpur of the upazila. According to the case, the girl went to Daulatpur Girls' High School to collect her SSC testimonial and marksheets on June 18. She was intercepted on way back home from the school by Mizan who took her to a nearby abandoned house with the help of Helal and raped her. Officer in-charge (OC) of Daulatpur police station Shawkat Alami said, the girl was undergoing treatment and police were trying to arrest the alleged rapists.

## Youth found dead

Police recovered the body of a youth from a banana garden at Jughuda village under Moshespur upazila yesterday. The deceased was identified as Ilias Hossain, 25, son of Abdul Hakim of the village. Officer In-Charge of Moshespur Police Station Akram Hossain said Ilias left his house on Tuesday evening to go to a local market and since then he went missing. The following day, a few farmers found the body at the orchard and informed the police. The body was sent to Jhenidah Sadar Hospital morgue for autopsy, said the OC.

## Extortionists stab two

Extortionists stabbed a man and his son as they refused to pay them toll at Barodaha village in Gobindaganj upazila on Monday night. The injured were identified as Rafiqul Islam Bablu, a member of local union parishad, and his son Shafiqul Islam. They were admitted to Gaibandha Sader Hospital. A gang attacked the duo with sharp weapons, leaving them seriously injured when they were returning to home from Naleya area. Earlier, the extortionists demanded Tk 10,000 from Rafiqul Islam, also the bidder of a road construction work.

## Missing Jubo League man rescued

Missing local Jubo League leader of Shahjahanpur upazila was rescued from Mohakhali area in Dhaka in an unconscious state on Tuesday night.

Al-Amin, 30, is general secretary of Majhuri union unit of Jubo League.

Al-Amin's elder brother Lutfar Rahman said one of their relatives found his brother in senseless condition in the capital and brought him to the home yesterday.

Assistant Superintendent of Police said Al-Amin left the home willingly on June 20.

However, family members said Al-Amin went missing on June 20 while he was going to Bogra town.

## 17 sued for killing Jubo Dal leader

Seventeen people, including alleged local terrorist Ibrahim Hossain Ratan, have been sued on charge of killing Kashipur unit Juba Dal leader Selim Hossain.

Lucky Begum, wife of the victim, filed the case against the 17--seven of them identified and 10 unidentified--with Laxmipur Sadar police station on Monday evening.

Selim was injured critically as members of a local gang, Ratan Bahini, allegedly swooped on him and sprayed bullets on him indiscriminately at Kashipur village in Laxmipur Sadar police station on Saturday night.

Selim died at Noakali General Hospital early Sunday.



## Jamuna continues to devour villages

Ten more villages are under threat of erosion by the River Jamuna in Phulchhari and Saghatta upazilas of the district.

The villages are Gobindia, Bashhatta, Digholkandi, Uttar Sathalia, Hashbari and Hasilkandi in Saghatta upazila; and Gajaria, Galna, Namapara and Kamarpara in Phulchhari upazila, said an official of Water Development Board (WDB) in the district.

The river devoured homesteads and a vast tract of farmland also went into the river, said farmer Amjad Hossain of Hasilkandi village under Saghatta upazila.

More than 20 families of Hashbari village in the upazila left their homesteads for safer places in fear of further erosion as the

authorities concerned did not take measures to check erosion, they alleged.

Finding no other way, local people on self help basis erected bamboo spares at Hasilkandi point and dumped sand bags to protect the erosion last year, but all were later washed away by the surging water.

A number of homesteads and a vast tract of farmland also went into the river, said farmer Amjad Hossain of Hasilkandi village under Saghatta upazila.

More than 20 families of Hashbari village in the upazila left their homesteads for safer places in fear of further erosion as the

river marked a sharp rise due to downpour in the last one week, said Abdur Rouf, former chairman of Saghatta Union Parishad.

My homestead is now only few yards off the erosion point and it might go into water anytime, said Rafiqul Mia of Hasilkandi village.

Rezaul Mostafa Ashafuddowla, executive engineer of the Water Development Board (WDB), Gaibandha, said we have already sought funds from the higher authority to check erosion.

We, however, have taken temporary measures to check erosion at different points, he said.

## Drive to demolish illegal structures

Patuakhali district administration yesterday started drive to remove illegal structures from the bank of Lawkhali River flowing by the town, as per directives issued by the High Court.

Executive Magistrate Asifur Rahman accompanied by police and Rabi led the operation that started at about 10:00am.

There is plan to remove about 2,000 illegal structures on about four kilometres

area of the riverbank from the ferry terminal to Jainkathi via the launch terminal, said sources of the district administration.

Following a writ petition filed by Khondaker Habibur Rahman of Kathpatti area in Patuakhali town, the High Court on May 20 this year issued an order to the district administration to remove illegal structures on the riverbank, said Amitav Sarker, deputy commissioner of Patuakhali.
