Singapore-based company returns 105 of its 144 acre controversially leased-out land

The Civil Aviation Authority of Bangladesh has repossessed its 105 acres of land worth more than Tk 3,000 crore from a Singaporebased company that had been controversially awarded the lease of the land next to the Shahjalal International Airport back in

There is a plan to use the repossessed land to construct a third terminal with 32

boarding bridges at the Shahjalal airport. But it will be decided on the basis of a master plan for the airport, Caab Chairman Air Vice-Marshal Mahmud Hussain told The Daily Star.

A consultant has already been appointed for preparing the master plan, he said.

The Egyptian army toppled Islamist President Mohamed Morsi yesterday after a week of bloodshed that killed nearly 50 people as millions took to the streets to demand an end to his turbulent single year of rule.

The announcement, made on state television by Morsi's own defence minister, armed forces chief

General Abdel Fattah al-Sisi, drew a rapturous welcome from the protesters who have camped out on the streets of Cairo for days. Sisi also announced a freezing of the Islamist-drafted


