

DOCTOR OF FALSE CERTIFICATES DGHS starts investigation

The Directorate General of Health Services (DGHS) has initiated an investigation into the trading of fictitious medical certificates by a physician at a private diagnostic centre in the capital's Chankharpool intersection. Meanwhile, Bangladesh Medical and Dental Council (BMDC) served the physician, Dr Md Saiful Islam, a notice around a week back, asking to explain about foreign degrees he claims to his name. Following a June 19 The Daily Star news report, "Doctor of false certificates", a three-member probe committee headed by DGHS Assistant Director Dr Md Emdadul Haq was formed on June 23. Yesterday the committee recorded deposition of an affected complainant and reporter of the said report.

Posing as an emergency doctor of Dhaka Medical College Hospital, Saiful, for the past several years at National Diagnostic Centre, has been dealing in fictitious medical certificates and injury reports for framing people in false criminal cases. Records show that Saiful, an officer on special duty at DGHS since July 2008, renewed his registration number with BMDC as a physician 17 years back. He claims on his business card, prescription notepad and the centre holding "fellowship-CBE and PHC from India and Malaysia, degree on C-Ultra, BSU and TGU from America and an FMD course". Saiful has only an MBBS degree, said BMDC Registrar Dr Zahidul Haq Basunia, adding that claiming to have foreign degrees not recognised by the council was illegal.

BISWAJIT MURDER CASE Court asks SI to face it on July 14

A Dhaka court yesterday summoned Md Jalal Uddin, a sub-inspector of Sutrapur Police Station and also the complainant of the Biswajit Das killing case, to appear before it on July 14 to narrate the murder. Some activists of Bangladesh Chhatra League allegedly stabbed Biswajit, 24, proprietor of Amantron Tailors in Shankharibazar area of Sutrapur, to death during a road blockade programme of BNP-led 18-party alliance on last December 9. The jail authorities produced eight accused, now in jail, before the court when Judge (in-charge) Dewan Md Shafiqullah of Speedy Trial Tribunal-4 passed the order yesterday. Thirteen others are still at large. Twenty one BCL activists of Jagannath University were indicted on June 2 for the gruesome murder. On June 30, the case was sent to the Speedy Trial Tribunal-4 of Dhaka from the Metropolitan Sessions Judge's Court in Dhaka as per a home ministry decision.

FOUR CITY POLLS HC rejects plea challenging use of political banners

The High Court yesterday rejected a writ petition filed for challenging the legality of the "use of political banners" in the Rajshahi, Sylhet, Barisal and Khulna city corporation elections on June 15. The HC bench of Justice Quazi Reza-Ul Hoque and Justice ABM Altaf Hossain rejected the petition saying that it was not adequately pressed, Deputy Attorney General Bishwojit Roy told The Daily Star. He also said Supreme Court lawyer Eunos Ali Akond, who earlier submitted the petition, yesterday could not make any argument on relevant legal points and could not answer any question asked by the judges. Eunos, however, could not be contacted for comments despite repeated attempts over the phone. The petition was filed on June 15 also seeking an HC directive on the Election Commission not to declare the official results of the four elections until further order. Eunos, in his petition, said the main political party leaders had supported their favoured mayoral candidates violating the code of conduct during campaigns.

'UNHINDERED' WIDENING OF ROAD RCC gives away four trees to local goons

Rajshahi City Corporation (RCC) cut down 11 large trees instead of seven, sold through a tender to widen a road, and gave away the excess four to local goons so that the widening could be completed without "hindrance". "We would have been unable to complete the work without honouring the demands of the local youths," said RCC Chief Engineer Ashraf Haque yesterday. The timber of the four trees - a "tamarind", a "koroi" and two eucalyptuses - cut last week hardly had any value, he said, adding, "Besides, we could not find any other way to widen the road without cutting those trees." The remaining seven trees - two "koroi", one "kathbadam", one eucalyptus and three palm trees - were sold to Rajshahi Krira O Shangkritik Shanga at Tk 2.01 lakh, fixed after consultations with the forest department, he said. The 250-metre road stretches from Fire Brigade intersection to the banks of the Padma river.
