

DEMAND FOR CG Public has shown support by electing BNP-backed mayors Says Fakhru

BNP acting secretary general Mirza Fakhru Islam Alamgir yesterday claimed that the public has shown its support for the demand for restoration of the caretaker government system through electing BNP-backed mayoral candidates in the five city corporation polls.

He asked the prime minister to step down immediately and hold the next parliamentary polls under the caretaker government. "The prime minister should understand what the public wants and restore the caretaker government," he said.

Fakhru was addressing the inaugural session of a photo exhibition on Tarique Rahman, BNP senior vice-chairman, at Jatiya Press Club in the capital.

Referring to Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina's remark in London that the parliamentary polls would be held like in any other democratic country, the opposition leader asked her not to make such comments.

He said in democratic countries police do not harass opposition leaders or attack their rallies.

Fakhru asked the prime minister to give up her self-willed nature and restore the caretaker government.

Healthcare for elderly people remains inadequate

Workshop told

While the proportion of people aged 60 and above is rapidly increasing in the country, the healthcare services for them remains inadequate and lacks coverage, said researchers at a workshop yesterday.

At present, the elderly account for seven percent of the population. It is estimated that by 2050, the elderly population will rise to 20 percent, they added.

The workshop at the auditorium of icddr, b in the capital was organ-

ised by consultant firm Eusuf and Associates (EAA).

It was held to disseminate the findings of research on "Behavioural Factors, Food Security and Health Related Quality of Life among Rural Elderly", conducted by EEA.

The study recommended that old homes be established in every district with free food, lodging, and medical care for the poor and helpless while those who can afford the services may pay for them. Md Shafiqul Islam Laskar, additional secretary of health ministry was also present.

5 cops sued over theft in Khulna

A woman sued five cops of Khulna Kotwali Police Station and a police source as they allegedly ransacked her house and stole valuables in Khulna city on Monday.

Panna Khatun, daughter of Sirajul Islam, of Shariabad Lane at Mahirbari Khalpar, filed the case accusing the six, including Sub-inspector Md Hafizur Rahman, with Khulna Chief Metropolitan Magistrate Court "Ka Anchal".

The case statement said a police team, led by SI Hafizur, went to Panna's house in the morning and stole Tk 15,000, and valuables, including gold ornaments worth about Tk 40,000 in the name of searching.

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10 hurt as cops disperse JCD procession at RU

At least 10 people, including a journalist and a shopkeeper, were injured as police fired rubber bullets and used batons to disperse a motorcycle procession of Jatiyatabadi Chhatra Dal (JCD) activists on Rajshahi University campus yesterday.

Political meeting, procession, and assembly are banned at RU.

Of the injured, Abdul Barek, a shopkeeper at the university's Kazla gate, suffered a gunshot wound in the face, while Shahabuddin, reporter of the local daily Rajshahir Alo, sustained bruises in the right leg. They were admitted to Rajshahi Medical College Hospital.

JCD leaders said at least eight of around 30 leaders and activists of the pro-BNP student body who joined the procession were injured. Led by RU unit JCD convener Abdullah Al Mamun, they stayed about 15 minutes on the campus before being driven out by police.

Police also arrested five JCD men, including Mahfuzur Rahman, Fajzur Rahman Foyez, Ihsan Haque, Atik Rahman and Rana, for defying the ban slapped by the university authorities.

RU unit JCD convener Arafat Reza Ashik said police "attacked the JCD men without any reason". The JCD activists went to the campus "to attend classes and examinations", he claimed. "They did not want to create any untoward situation."

Police, however, stayed mum when some 25-30 leaders and activists of Bangladesh Chhatra League, an Awami League-backed student body, brought out a procession from Tukitaki Chhatra yesterday. RU unit BCL president Ahmed Ali led the march.

Witnesses said police also breakfasted with the BCL men in front of the senate building.

Ashit Kumar Ghosh, officer-in-charge of Motihar Police Station, however, denied that BCL brought out a procession. About breakfasting with BCL men, he said they (BCL men) came to discuss the campus situation with them, he said.

Proctor Prof Tariqul Hasan said police resisted the procession as political activities were banned at the university.

TRAFFIC JAM IN RAMADAN

Govt urged to reduce private vehicles in capital

Speakers at a press conference yesterday urged the government to increase public buses and minimise the number of private vehicles on the streets of the capital to alleviate public sufferings and traffic congestion during Ramadan.

They also placed some recommendations, including fixing office leave, stopping vehicle parking on the streets, and ensuring sufficient services through bus, train and river routes.

They were addressing a press conference on "Traffic jam in Ramadan and Eid, accident, removing vehicles' crisis and normal transportation" organised by Poribesh Bachao Andolan, and WBB Trust at Poba office in the capital.

WBB Trust National Advocacy Programme Officer Maruf Rahman said around 95 percent people had to suffer due to traffic congestion only for 5 percent private vehicles which cover more than 70 percent area on the streets. Poba Secretary Abdus Sobhan and WBB Trust Development Officer Samiul Hasan Sajib also spoke.
