It also said he will be accountable to the Awami League president. The appointment will come into effect immediately, said the PMO order.

Labourer dies in workplace accident

An elderly labourer died as he fell to the ground while carrying a sack of rice on the head inside a warehouse at Babubazar in Old Dhaka yesterday. The deceased was Abdul Jalil, 60, of Subhadda Paschimpara in Dakkhin Keraniganj. Manik Mia, son of Jalil, claimed that some sacks of rice piled up in the store house fell on his father, leaving him dead. Jalil was declared dead at Dhaka Medical College Hospital.

Vested property return tribunals formed in each district

The government has set up vested property return tribunals at the first joint district judge court in every district. In some cases, the tribunals have been set up at the sadar joint district judge courts. Vested property return additional tribunals have also been formed in the districts. The Law and Justice Division of the Ministry of Law, Justice and Parliamentary Affairs issued an SRO notification on Wednesday in this regard, said an official release yesterday.

Korean corner opens at DU

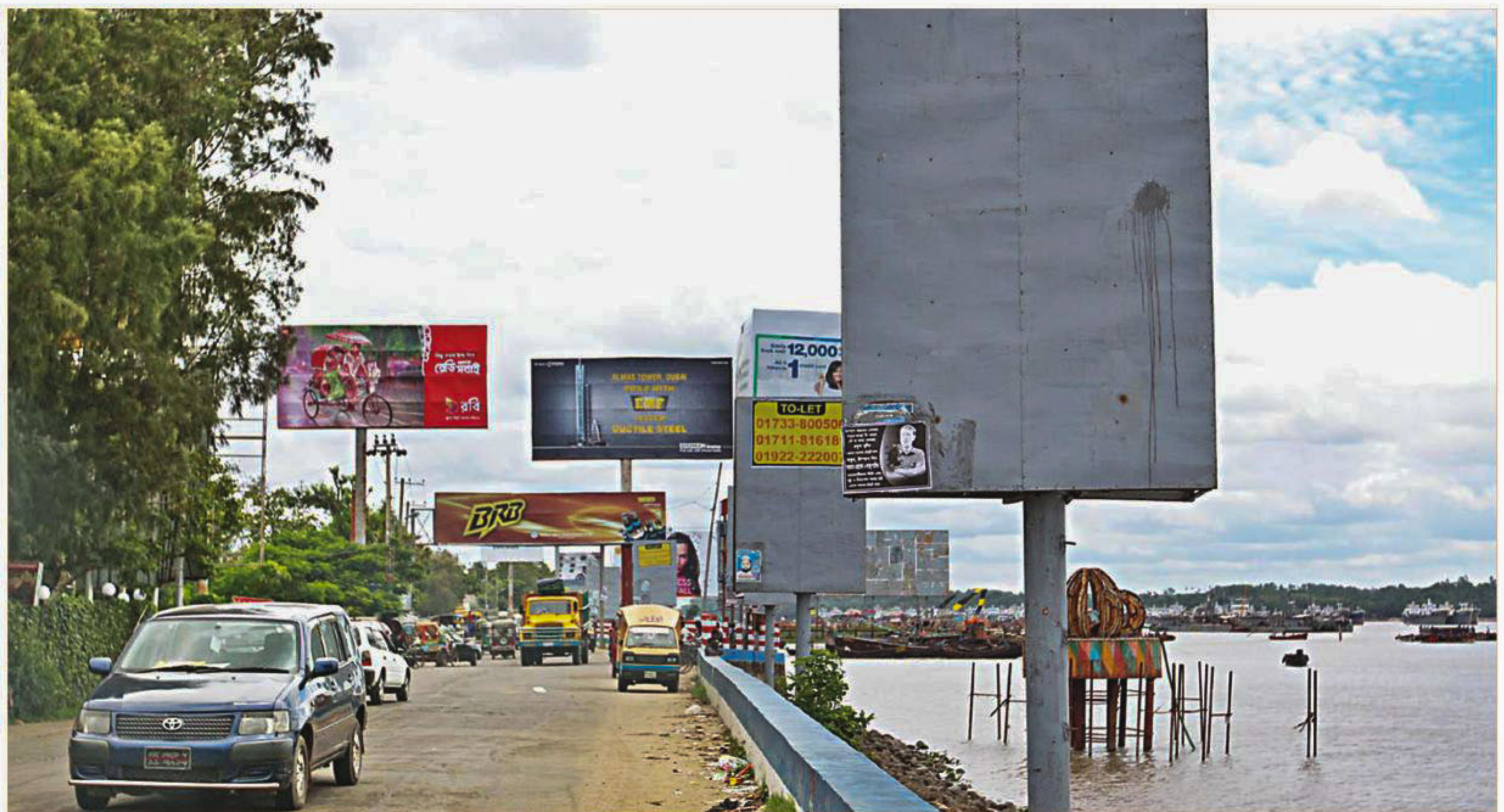

Zabid Ahsan Sohel, the youngest son of late Awami League lawmaker Ahsan Ullah Master, died at Mount Elizabeth Hospital in Singapore yesterday. He was 33. He left behind his three-year-old daughter, wife, mother, a brother and a sister. Md Ataur Rahman, an uncle of Sohel, said he had been suffering from pancreas disease. Sohel was admitted to Apollo Hospitals Dhaka on April 22 first and, later, shifted to Singapore. He will be buried tomorrow beside his father's grave at Haidarabad in Gazipur sadar.

Road crashes kill 14, injure 19

Fourteen people were killed and 19 others injured in separate road accidents across the country on Wednesday and yesterday. Our staff correspondent reports, a beggar died after a car ran her over in the capital's Banasree yesterday. The deceased, Amena Begum, 85, resided in East Rampura. Our Chittagong correspondent adds, two people were killed and another was injured in different road accidents in Chittagong yesterday. Md Alamgir, 22, a helper in a human hauler, was killed when the vehicle collided head-on with a car on Sitakunda Bypass Road in Sitakunda upazila. Meanwhile in Halihsahar area, Md Mamun, 32, died after a truck hit his motorbike in the port city. In Chaumuhuni area, Nurul Alam, 8, was injured as a CNG-run auto-rickshaw hit him at Rangunia upazila. He was admitted to Chittagong Medical College Hospital. Our Jhenidah correspondent reports, two passengers of a battery-run three-wheeler were killed and two others injured when a BRTC bus rammed the vehicle near Chandpur bus stand on Kushtia-Jhenidah highway yesterday. The dead, Sahidul Islam, 33, and Laltu Mia, 35, hailed from Sailkupa upazila. The injured were rushed to Jhenidah Sadar Hospital. Agitated locals vandalised the bus and blocked the highway for an hour. Our Natore correspondent adds, a passenger of a rickshaw was killed while the rickshaw puller injured when a truck rammed the vehicle at Gazirbeel in Natore Sadar upazila yesterday. The deceased was Sohrab Akhanda, 60. Our Gazipur correspondent adds, Shohel Dhali, 33, died after a bus hit his motorbike on Dhaka-Mymensingh highway before RAK Ceramics on Wednesday. Our Bogra correspondent reports, a helper in a bus died after the vehicle hit a standing truck at Mirzapur on Bogra-Dhaka highway in Sherpur upazila yesterday. The deceased was Aminul Islam, 28, of Gaibandha. Our Dinajpur correspondent adds, two persons were killed when a truck hit their motorbike in Ghoraghat upazila of Dinajpur on Wednesday. The dead are Mahfuzar Rahman, 25, and Milon Mondal, 24, of Ghoraghat upazila. A Comilla correspondent reports, three people were killed when a pick-up van rammed their motorbike at Horicher near Kachkata in Sadar Dakshin upazila yesterday. The dead are Abu Abdullah Aslam, 24, final year student of Comilla Medical College, and Dr Ashiqur Rahman Suman, 26, of Laksam upazila, and Jony Mia, 22, of Comilla City. Our Rajshahi correspondent adds, a person was killed and 15 others were injured as a Rajshahi University students' bus collided head-on with a human hauler at Bonodpur Bazar in the city yesterday. The deceased was Bichhad Ali, 45, driver of the human hauler. The injured passengers of the human hauler were admitted to Rajshahi Medical College Hospital.
