Clash over capture of khas land, 100 hurt

Over 100 people were injured during a clash between two groups of villagers over capture of a khas land on the border of two adjacent villages--Laltitekhar and Borokhurma--in Biswanath upazila in the district on Wednesday night.

Police said the clash ensued at around 7:00pm when the villagers of Laltitekhar went to the land to cultivate aman. Hearing the news, people of Borokhurma, equipped with lethal weapons swooped on their opponents, prompting them to retaliate.
