# Musa talks about his Mt Elbrus conquest

Musa Ibrahim, the first Bangladeshi to conquer Everest, has added another feather in his cap by reaching the summit of the highest mountain in Europe, Mt Elbrus.

He disclosed the details of his journey to Elbrus's peak at a press conference in the capital's Russian Cultural Center yesterday. His compatriots for the expedition included Niaz Patwary, who had previously accompanied Musa Ibrahim in conquering

Mt Kilimanjaro, and Sifat Fahmida Nowshin. The trio, identifying themselves as Team Bangladesh, raised the national flag at 18,510 feet, on the peak of Mt Elbrus, on June 26, revealed a jubilant Sifat.

"I hope that our accomplishment will encourage others to join mountaineering as well," said Musa.

Elbrus, a dormant volcano nestled within the Caucasus mountain range, was the third mountain to be conquered in Musa's conquest to conquer the seven highest mountains of the seven continents.

The expedition was sponsored by Summit Group, Fareast Islami Life Insurance Company Ltd and Abdul Monem Ltd, and organised by mountaineering groups North Alpine Club Bangladesh and Everest Academy.
