9 held while going to Malaysia illegally

Members of Border Guard Bangladesh (BGB) yesterday arrested nine people while they were going to Malaysia illegally.

The arrestees are Md Ali, 35, Imtiaz Ali, 32, Jahur Hossain, 38, Md Salam, 24, Mahbubur Rahman, 25, Shafikur Rahman, 26, Md Nasim, 25, Abdul Amin, 30, and Akramul, 32.

Lt Col Zahid Hasan, commander of 42 BGB battalion in Teknaf of said a team of border gurards at Damdamia check post arrested them from an autorickshaw on Cox's Bazar-Teknaf highway while searching the three-wheeler on suspicion.

Earlier, the BGB men arrested Sirajul Islam Kalu of Jessore, one of the traffickers, who lured the nine promising to send them to Malaysia at low cost, said the commander.

Young couple 'commit suicide'

A young man and a girl allegedly committed suicide by hanging themselves from a tree in Chhatak upazila early yesterday.

The deceased were identified as Abdullah, 25, and Kulsum Begum, 19, of Ketia Charvillage in the upazila.

Officer in-charge of Chhatak police station Shah Jalal Munshi said locals found the bodies of Abdullah and Kulsum hanging from the same tree branch in the morning and informed police.

The bodies were recovered and sent them to the hospital morgue for autopsy.

Locals said Abdullah and Kulsum had long been in love with each other However, their families continued to refuse to accept the affair.

43 Bhola villages flooded again

High tide coupled with a downpour inundated 43 villages in five upazilas of Bhola district yesterday, marooning around 1.5 lakh people.

The affected people said water from the river Meghna entered the damaged portions of the flood control embankments in the upazilas. They blamed the authorities concerned for not taking steps to repair the dykes damaged a year ago.

Nine villages in Sadar upazila, 15 villages in Borhanuddin upazila, 13 villages in Tazumuddin upazila, four villages in Daulatkhan upazila and two villages in Monpura upazila are now under water.

The affected people have taken shelter on high lands, roads and highways and at cyclone shelters in their respective areas. They face acute crises of food and pure drinking water.

Tidal surge under the impact of full moon and new moon submerged the village twice in 45 days as five kilometres damaged dyke from Tulatoli of Dhania union to Miar Haat of Elisha union under Sadar upazila, three kilometres from Alimuddin village of Boromanika union under Borhanuddin upazila to Sayedpur union under Daulatkhan upazila, and half a kilometer in Dorichandpur area under Chadpur union of Tazumuddin upazila have remained without repair for a year

Md Abdul Hannan, executive engineer of Water Development Board (Div-1), they could not start repair works in the dry season due to lack of funds.

Shahidul Islam Talukder, executive engineer of Water Development Board (Div-2), said they have completed the tender process for constructing a new dyke in Tazumuddin.

10 outlaws get life for murder

A Pabna court yesterday sentenced 10 underground operatives to life imprisonment in a murder case.

Judge Amulla Kumar of the Special Judge's Court, Pabna, pronounced the verdict in a crowded courtroom at noon.

The lifers are Mojahar Ali, Nazir Sheikh, Abdus Samad-1, Abdus Samad-2, Md Mokbul Hossain, Ibrahim Ali Mridha, Abu Taher, Masud Khan, Eskan Pramanik and Bolai Mishtri.

Of them, Nazir Sheikh, Abdus Samad-1, Abdus Samad-2, Ibrahim Ali and Bolai Mishtri died in encounters with law enforcers at different times, court sources said. According to the case statement, the

operatives of outlawed Purbo Banglar Communist Party (PBCP-Lal Pataka) hacked Md Tayeb Ali, an agriculture officer of Pabna Sadar upazila, to death while he was coming to his office on March 9, 1996. A case was filed with Pabna Sadar Police

Station the same day, accusing the 10 PBCB men. After investigation, police pressed charges against the outlaws on November, 17, 1996, said Public Prosecutor (PP) advocate Abdus Samad Khan Ratan.

Man grabs portion of school playground

Admin seems to turn blind eye

An influential local is building a concrete structure, grabbing a portion of the playground of Kashem Sardar Government Primary School at Charoni Patyashi village in Zianagar upazila of the district.

Mamun Islam backed by some locals has started construction of a concrete house on the southeastern side of the school playground a few days ago,

claiming the ownership of the land. Though Mamun claims

that he is the real owner of the land, he could not show any papers to substantiate his claim, said Nazrul Islam Khan, headmaster of the school.

"We have already informed the upazila education officer of the matter and sought his immediate intervention to save the land," the headmaster added.

Md Kazi Bashir Ahmed,

an assistant teacher of the school, said construction of a concrete structure on the land is going on, but local administration is yet to take any step to stop it.

Contacted, Upazila Education Officer Md Ibrahim said some ruling party men have assured him of resolving the issue as soon as possible. "If they fail to solve the problem, we shall go for legal action against the man," the education officer said.
