The People's Republic of Bangladesh (GOB) has received a credit from International Development Association (the Bank) in an amount of US\$ 375 million and a Grant from Pilot Program for Climate Resilience (PPCR), one of the targeted programs of the Strategic Climate Fund (SCF) under the Climate Investment Funds (CIF) of US\$ 25 million to meet the implementation cost of the CEIP-1.
