

Jewellery traders in Chandpur protest attack by criminals

A CORRESPONDENT, Chandpur Jewellery shops owners in the town observed a token strike for four hours from 10:00am yesterday, protesting attacks on their shops by an unidentified gang on Monday night.

Jewellers and witnesses said a gang of 20 to 25 criminals, equipped with lethal weapons, attacked Noloek Jewellers, Suchana Jewellers, Panna Jewellers and Lucky Jewellers on Comilla Road at around 9:00pm, vandalised shutters and glasses of the shops and left the scene. Being informed, police led by Officer-in-Charge Shah Alam (investigation) of Chandpur Model Police Station, visited the spot. Later, the law enforcers conducted a raid in the town and arrested three youths named Sajjad, 16, Rahat, 17, and Rakib, 16, at the auto rickshaw stand, suspecting their involvement in the attacks.

Gangsters capture market, land in Gabtoli of Bogra

One killed, 50 hurt in 2 other districts

A local influential group grabbed a vegetable market and its adjacent land, around 300 meters away from Gabtoli police station in Bogra district on Monday, reports our correspondent. A police said there was a longstanding conflict between two groups—one led by Kazi Nazrul Islam and another by Mithu Mia—over ownership of the market on 36 decimal of land and its adjacent area in Gabtoli upazila.

Monday afternoon, alleged locals. Contacted, Kazi Nazrul Islam said Mithu had grabbed the entire land although an appeal was pending in the court on the issue. Mithu said he constructed the market on his paternal property and there was no direction by the court. Two cases were filed in connection with the incident, said Lutfur Rahman, officer in-charge (investigation) of the PS.

In a clash between two rival groups over a disputed land in Charmanikda area of the town on Monday evening. Police fired 10 rubber bullets to bring the situation under control, reports a correspondent. Locals said there was a longstanding feud between one Seken Molla and Ebadot Molla of Charmanikda village over the land. The supporters of the duo engaged in an altercation over the issue, leaving 20 from both sides injured. Of them, four were admitted to Gopalganj Sadar Hospital while the rest given first aid, said Md Zakir Hossain Molla, officer in-charge of Gopalganj police station.

Jute, products and machinery gutted

A devastating fire gutted large quantities of raw materials, jute products and machinery at Quality Jute Mills in Feni BSCIC industrial area early yesterday.

mills soon after a worker turned on a switch to start a machine at around 4:00am. The blaze soon spread to the other units and the warehouse of the tin-roofed jute mills on 2.25 acres of land, the manager said, adding that raw jute, threads and machinery worth around Tk 20 crore were destroyed by the fire.
