

FIGHTING HIV/AIDS Runa Laila as Saarc goodwill envoy leaves for New Delhi today

Celebrated artist Runa Laila is set to make her maiden trip abroad as a Saarc Goodwill Ambassador for HIV/AIDS leaving Dhaka for New Delhi today on a two-day visit, said a foreign ministry press release yesterday.

"During her visit, she will join relevant officials, singers and celebrities of India in a sensitisation programme, visit treatment and support centers for HIV/AIDS victims and will also meet the journalists at a press conference," the release said.

It added that the visit would be Laila's first tour to any Saarc member state in her capacity as the Saarc goodwill ambassador.

Laila was nominated as a Saarc goodwill ambassador for HIV/AIDS for 2013 and 2014 alongside Ajay Devgan of India and Sharmeen Obaid Chinoy of Pakistan.

Foreign Minister Dr Dipu Moni formally handed over the nomination letter to Runa Laila while the latter called on the foreign minister at her ministry office on April 23.

The Saarc goodwill ambassador programme was conceived in 2008 with a view to engaging regionally well-known personalities to create greater awareness about HIV/AIDS in South Asia and to facilitate the implementation of Saarc Regional Strategy and its Work Plan on HIV/AIDS.

CU JCD men 'attacked by BCL, police'

Around 13 Jatiyatabadi Chhatra Dal (JCD) activists of Chittagong University unit were injured in separate attacks allegedly by Bangladesh Chhatra League men and police on the campus and at Chittagong Medical College Hospital (CMCH) in the last two days.

Both BCL and police denied the allegations. The university unit JCD Senior Vice President Nesarul Islam Nazmul said 10-12 Chhatra League activists, led by CU unit Assistant Secretary Mizanur Rahman Minu, suddenly attacked their activists with rods on the campus Monday night, leaving five injured.

When they took their fellows to CMCH for treatment that night, police beat them up following an altercation, injuring two more activists, he said. Nazmul said the quarrel broke out when police barred their activists from entering the hospital along with the injured.

Duty officer at CMCH police box Nayek Jahangir Alam, however, denied beating anyone, while CU unit BCL President Mamunul Hoque said the Chhatra Dal workers were injured in a factional clash.

Six more of the pro-BNP student activists were wounded when their procession to protest Monday night's assaults was attacked allegedly by BCL men on the campus yesterday. The six were admitted to a private clinic in the city. BCL leader Mamunul Hoque refuted the allegation of this attack too.

CTG ARMS HAUL IO accused of not continuing probe into Bongo Borak

Two defence lawyers yesterday alleged that the latest and fifth investigation officer (IO) refrained from continuing the probe into Bongo Borak, a container ship which allegedly carried the huge haul of arms and ammunition to Chittagong in 2004, since names of some ruling party men were about to emerge as owners of the vessel.

The investigator Mohammad Moniruzzaman Chowdhury, additional superintendent of police (SP) of the Criminal Investigation Department (CID), denied the allegation. He was being cross-examined by Kamrul Islam Sajjad and Mohammad Ahsan, counsels for Brig Gen (ret) Abdur Rahim, former director general of National Security Intelligence (NSI), an accused in the arms haul cases.

Bongo Borak is a vessel of HRC Shipping owned by Sayeed Hossain, brother of ruling party lawmaker Saber Hossain Chowdhury.

The defence lawyers also asked Moniruzzaman if he had interrogated late film director Ajmal Huda Mithu and businessman Salman F Rahman since some witnesses and accused earlier stated that these two persons and others used to visit some "safe houses" in Dhaka where the

arms smuggling was allegedly plotted.

The IO said he did not question them.

Talking to The Daily Star, advocate Kamrul said some witnesses and accused made mentions of the visits of Mithu, Rahman, HM Ershad and some others to about three "safe houses" at Gulshan and Baridhara.

Advocate Kamrul alleged that the fourth investigator of the cases, CID Assistant SP Md Ismail Hossain, had suspected Bongo Borak for shipping the arms and ammunition but the present government appealed to change the IO on the pretext that the investigation was not going on properly, and subsequently Moniruzzaman was appointed as the new IO upon political consideration. Moniruzzaman termed the allegations false.

When the lawyer asked Moniruzzaman if he had come across names of three vessels owned by HRC Shipping in connection with the arms smuggling, the IO replied that he learned about one vessel--Bongo Borak.

The huge haul of arms and ammunition arrived in two trawlers at the Chittagong Urea Fertiliser Ltd jetty on April 2, 2004. The haul was allegedly unloaded into the trawlers from a ship at the outer anchorage.

Chittagong Metropolitan Special Tribunal-1 fixed August 13 and 14 for next proceedings.

AMINUL MURDER CASE

Home ministry directs CID to inform it about probe progress

The home ministry yesterday asked the Criminal Investigation Department (CID) to inform it in seven days about the progress of the investigation into the labour rights activist Aminul Islam's murder.

The directives followed a similar order issued 11 days ago which failed to move the CID to act.

Aminul, 39, of the Bangladesh Centre for Workers Solidarity (BCWS), disappeared from Ashulia on April 4, 2012. His body was discovered two days later in Tangail.

No headway was made in the probe in almost 15 months into the murder.

The inaction to find and punish the perpetrators is believed to be one of the reasons for which the US cancelled Bangladesh's preferential trade benefits on June 27.

Teacher held for molesting students in Ctg

A teacher of Orbit Cadet School and College in Chittagong city was arrested yesterday on charges of molesting the second graders at the institution.

The institution authorities also sacked Osman Gani, 30, an Arabic teacher.

Some 50 guardians of the students of the institution and locals demonstrated before the principal's room around 10:00am yesterday, demanding punitive action against Osman. Police arrested him from the water tank of the school building where he was hiding.

Osman, 30, a resident of Maheshkhali upazila, Cox's Bazar, passed Fazil from Chunati Madrasa in Satkania upazila and

Kamil from Baitush Sharaf Madrasa in Chittagong city, said Atik Ahmed Chowdhury, officer-in-charge of Chawkbazar Police Station. He joined the school on January 1.

The guardians alleged that Osman had been sexually harassing the students, both girls and boys, by taking two or three of them to the rooftop every day during class time.

"I came to know of the matter on Monday from our domestic help as my son told her about being tortured by this teacher," Lokman Hossain told The Daily Star. After that the guardians called on the school principal, Nurul Alam, who confirmed that Osman was fired.

Lokman filed a case with Chawkbazar Police Station in this regard.
