Beijing has ruled out any imminent leaders' summit with Tokyo, Chinese staterun media said Tuesday after a Japanese official raised the possibility, in a rebuff underscoring tensions over a long-running maritime

Asia's two largest economies are locked in a bitter row over a string of islands in the resource-rich East China Sea, known as Diaoyu in China and

Senkaku in Japan. adviser to Japan's Prime Minister Shinzo Abe, said on Sunday after a visit to Beijing that a high-level summit "will be held in the not-so-distant future". A day earlier, Abe also said he would like to hold such

The official added that Iijima had not met any Chinese government officials, nor did either side discuss a leaders' meeting.

"Beijing (has) ruled out the possibility of an upcoming leaders' summit with Tokyo," the China Daily said.

Foreign ministry spokesman Hong Lei said in an online statement that "as far as I know", Iijima "has not engaged in any official activity in China, nor have officials of the Chinese government made contact with

Japanese Foreign Minister Fumio Kishida did not directly address the China Daily report at a regular briefing in Tokyo on

visit to China by his deputy this week would pave the way for talks.

"It is important to hold a summit meeting. We hope the visit will lead to such a dialogue," he said.

Diplomatic ties between the two have frayed since last September when Japan nationalised some of the islands, triggering street protests across China.

Tokyo controls the islands, but official Chinese ships regularly patrol the waters nearby -- believed to be potentially rich in petroleum deposits -- raising concerns over a possible confrontation.

The two countries are major trading partners, but have festering disagreements over Japan's imperial past and its invasion and occupation of parts of China.

Project cost up by 111pc

The allocation for the "Ektee Bari, Ektee Khamar (One House, One Farm)" project has been increased by 111 percent in the second revision to cover all unions of the country.

The Executive Committee of the National Economic Council (Ecnec) at a meeting in the NEC conference room yesterday approved the project's second revision with a cost of Tk 3,163 crore, and also extended its timeframe till June 2016.

Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina chaired the meeting.

The project was first approved in November 2009 with an estimated cost of Tk 1,200 crore. Later, the amount was increased to Tk 1,493 crore in the first revision of the project, and it covered 1,932 unions.

The footage shows that the punjabi-clad killer moved in on Milky from the latter's left side. He was talking on the mobile phone and started shooting at Milky, who fell on the ground on impact.

When Milky tried to get up, the killer kept firing at him to make sure that he was dead. The killer's face was not

clear in the footage. Rab later identified the man as HM Jahid Siddique alias Tarek, 35, joint secretary of the Dhaka City (south) unit Jubo League.

Two motorbikes arrived at the scene at the time of shooting, and the killer left the spot on one of those.

Kismat Hayat, commanding officer of Rab-1, said a separate footage showed that another young man also shot Milky at the same spot and left on a motorbike. It showed that a car was

parked in front of Milky's car at the mall's entrance before the shooting. That car left the place immediately after the incident, said Kismat.

When the killers were shooting at Milky, a policeman and a few others were near the entrance of the market.

Rab arrested prime suspect Tarek, Tuhinur Rahman, 25, Syed Mostafa Ali alias Rumi, 33, Mohammad Russel Mahmud, 25, Saidul Islam alias Nuruzzaman, 22, and Mohammad Suzon

Rab suspected that Milky might have been killed as a sequel to feuds over the formation of the Jubo League committee, tenders and establishing supremacy.

Milky was rushed to nearby Shahabuddin Medical College Hospital where doctors declared him dead.

The body was sent to Dhaka Medical College morgue for autopsy. It bore multiple bullet wounds, and at least four bullets were found in the victim's head and chest, said sources at the morgue.

Victim's family members said Milky, who lived in the capital's Mohammadpur area, had gone to Gulshan for shopping. But they declined to speak further.

The body was kept at the Birdem mortuary after namaje-janaza in front of the Awami League central office. The decision about his burial will be made after his brother arrives in Dhaka from the USA.

Hours after the incident, State Minister for Home Shamsul Haque Tuku told reporters at his secretariat office that the investigation will take its due course and the killers' political affiliation will not hamper it.
