## Hajj pilgrims free to choose airline: SC

The Supreme Court yesterday upheld a High Court order which ruled that pilgrims intent on going to Saudi Arabia to perform hajj could choose any airline.

Chamber judge Justice Syed Mahmud Hossain passed the order after hearing a petition filed by the government seeking stay on the HC order.

On April 24, the civil aviation ministry decided that only Biman Bangladesh Airlines and Saudi Arabian Airlines would carry Bangladesh's 1.27 lakh hajj pilgrims this year. Challenging the decision's legality, Hajj Agencies

Association of Bangladesh (Haab) Vice-President Abdul Kabir Khan and Secretary General Sheikh Abdullah and one pilgrim, Rezaul Islam, filed a writ petition on July 29.

That day the HC heard the petition, passed the order and issued a rule upon the government to explain in four weeks why the decision should not be declared illegal.

Yesterday, Haab President Md Ibrahim Bahar at a press conference in Haab's office urged the ministry not to challenge the HC directive.

## SC refuses to receive Gonojagoron Mancha memorandum


The Supreme Court authorities yesterday refused to receive a memorandum prepared by Gonojagoron Mancha demanding that the SC's Appellate Division continues hearing appeals against war crimes case verdicts during its vacation from tomorrow.

The SC can not receive such memorandums as per its rules, SC Registrar AKM Shamsul Islam told The Daily Star.

The memorandum also urged the chief justice to hold hearings on appeals of more than one case at a time.

Five Gonojagoron Mancha representatives led by Imran H Sarker placed copies of the memorandum at the offices of Attorney General Mahbubey Alam and State Minister for Law Qamrul Islam.

The Appellate Division heard appeals of the defence and prosecution against the life sentence of Jamaat leader Abdul Quader Mollah. The appeals against the death sentences for Delawar Hossain Sayedee and Muhammad Kamaruzzaman have been filed. The SC has a total of 49 working days in 2013.

A Dhaka court granted 45 more days to Criminal Investigation Department (CID) to complete the investigation in two cases filed over the Rana Plaza collapse as the department failed to submit the reports yesterday.

Senior Judicial Magistrate Kazi Shahidul Islam asked CID to submit the probe report by September 15.

Meanwhile, the court rejected the bail petitions of seven accused in the two

The accused are: Abdul Khalek, father of Sohel Rana and also owner of Rana Plaza, Refayet Ullah, suspended Savar municipality mayor and BNP leader, engineer Rafiqul Islam, Rana's relative Abdul Hassan, Bazlus Samad, chairman of New Wave Bottoms, Mahmudur Rahman Tapash, managing director of New Wave Bottoms, and engineer Rakibul Hassan Russel

On the other hand, Rana is yet to get any lawyer to defend him as per decision from Dhaka Bar Association, Additional Public Prosecutor Anwarul Kabir Babul told The Daily Star yesterday.

The court, however, placed BNP leader Refayet Ullah on a one-day remand for interrogation in the case filed for violating building code.

## Workers set fire to Gazipur factory for arrears, bonus OUR CORRESPONDENT, Gazipur

Some workers of Libas Textiles Ltd of Nishchintapur in Gazipur's Kaliakoir set fire to the factory after a meeting with owners over payment of their wages and festival bonus ended fruitlessly in Gazipur.

The workers claimed that they were protesting peacefully inside the factory when some of them locked the factory's main gate and carried out the arson attack.

Firefighters from Gazipur and Kaliakoir doused the fire. No casualty was reported till filing of this report yesterday evening.

Over 2,000 workers went on strike on Wednesday over demands, including payment of outstanding overtime of May, June and July; of July's salaries; and of 60 percent of their wage as festival bonus.

The workers said usually they received 60 percent of their gross salary as festival bonus but the authorities announced that 20 percent bonus of it would be given this year.

"Workers ransacked the factory in the morning. They also threw pieces of bricks and broke windowpanes," said Gazipur Industrial Police Inspector Md Swakat Kabir.

"The demands are completely unfair but we are holding discussions with them to maintain peace," said the com-

pany's Executive Director MA Mannan.

# Experts for comprehensive law on right to food in South Asia

South Asian experts and policymakers on food security yesterday stressed immediate enacting of a specialised and comprehensive law on right to food in the South Asian countries to address the region's prevailing chronic hunger.

Although each country has more than two dozens to hundreds of legal provisions relevant to food security, none of them directly addresses people's right to food, they said at a two-day regional consultation on food-related legislations in South Asia held in Kathmandu, Nepal, said a message received in Dhaka yes-

a lot in terms of direct and indirect investment in food and agriculture. Many laws, rules, regulations, policies, and administrative measures have been introduced, but these are not coherent and comprehensive," said Information Minister and Chairperson of the All Party Parliamentary Group on Food, Agriculture and Rural Development Hasanul Haq Inu.

It is hard to find poor people having three meals everyday with the existing legal loopholes and many related issues missing, Inu said adding that the right to food bill in India could be an inspiration for other countries. Lilian Mercado, deputy regional director of

Oxfam Asia, said though South Asia has experienced the second fastest rate of economic growth in the world, poverty has gotten worse as inequality has risen and become more severe. "Studies showed it could grow at the steady

rate of around 5.5 percent in the next 25 years. But, factors such as climate change, inequality, food price hike, population growth, rapid urbanisation as well as competition for natural resources could hamper or reverse the progress. It reflects a need for the South Asian governments to transform their political pledges on food security into immediate action," she said.

During the meeting, about 50 representatives from Bangladesh, India, Nepal, Pakistan, and Sri Lanka discussed the findings mentioned in the Regional Synthesis Report on foodrelated legislations in each of the country.

### LONG-STALLED ELECTIONS TO DCCs Why EC, govt will not be asked to declare dates: HC

The High Court yesterday asked the government and the Election Commission to explain in four weeks why they should not be directed to take necessary steps and to announce a schedule for holding the long-stalled elections to the two Dhaka city corporations.

The HC bench of Justice Mirza Hussain Haider and Justice Muhammad Khurshid Alam Khan came up with the rule after hearing two separate writ petitions, filed by four Supreme Court lawyers on Sunday, seeking the court directives regarding the elections. Golam Nabi and Mostafa Ahmed filed a petition

while Md Alamgir Hossain and Mirza Al Mahmood for the election to the Dhaka South City Corporation. The petitions say the city elections should have been held within 180 days from the date of their establishment on December 1, 2011, as per the Local

for the Dhaka North City Corporation election,

(Amended in 2011). Bodruddoza Badal appeared for the petitioners, while Attorney General Mahbubey Alam opposed the petition.




