

# 60 goats killed as truck plunges into ditch

At least 60 goats were killed as a truck carrying them to Dhaka plunged into a roadside ditch in Kaliganj upazila of the district on Tuesday night.

A truck with 80 goats on board was going to the capital from Borobazar in the upazila. When the vehicle reached Ghoramara Bridge near Rognathpur Bazar at around 8:30pm, it skidded off Dhaka-Khulna highway and fell into a roadside ditch.

At least 60 goats died on the spot and 15 others went missing, said trader Zahidul Islam. He said the truck met with the accident as the trucker lost control over the steering.

Zahidul said he purchased the goats from Borobazar for Tk 3 lakh and was sending them in the truck to Gabtoli in the capital for sale.

In Pabna, an unknown disease claimed the lives of 18 cows at Ishwardi Military Dairy Farm in two days, reports UNB.

Of them, 13 died on Sunday while the remaining five on Monday, said Ishwardi upazila livestock officer Mohiuddin.

Pabna district livestock officer Dr Saiful Islam, Ishwardi livestock officer Mohiuddin, Ishwardi upazila veterinary surgeon Dr Nasrin Parvin visited the dairy farm on Tuesday. But they could not confirm which disease caused the death of the cows.

Samples from the dead cows were sent to Dhaka for laboratory test, dairy farm sources said.

# Clashes over land dispute kill man, injure 40

A man was killed and at least 40 others were injured in two clashes over disputed lands in Sylhet and Sunamganj districts on Tuesday and the day before.

At least 40 people were injured in a clash between two rival groups at Paikraj village in Goainghat upazila of Sylhet on Tuesday, reports UNB.

Sources said, there had been a longstanding dispute between Ruhul Amin and Bilal Member over ownership of land of local Paikraj Primary School and Jame Mosque.

As a sequel to it, two groups -- one led by Ruhul

Amin and another by Bilal -- locked in a clash at 1.00pm after they failed to settle the dispute at a local arbitration.

The clash left at least 40 people injured on both sides.

Of them, 16 critically injured were rushed to Sylhet Osmani Medical

College Hospital while the rest given treatment in a local hospital.

In Sunamganj, a man was killed as two groups of villagers clashed over a land dispute at Niamatpur village in Doarabazar upazila on Monday evening.

The deceased was identified as Abul Mia, 31, son of

late Soab Ali of the village.

Locals said, there had been a longstanding conflict between Abdun Nur and Chan Mia of the village over ownership of a piece of land.

As a sequel to the conflict, men of Abdun Nur suddenly attacked Chan Mia's supporter Abul Mia while he was returning home from Dohalia Bazar at about 5:30pm.

Informed, Chan Mia's men reached the spot and both the groups equipped with lethal weapons locked in a clash.

Abul died on the spot after being hit with sharp weapons by the rivals.

# Bldg collapse kills woman, daughter

A woman and her daughter were killed as a pillar of their under-construction building fell on them in Rajarhat Bazar area of Sadar upazila yesterday.

The deceased were identified as Momena Khatun, 75, and her daughter Marjina Khatun, 40, of the area.

Officer-in-charge (investigation) of Kotwali Police Station M Rafiqul Islam said, a pillar of the under-construction building collapsed at about 7am when a soil-laden truck hit the pillar after its driver lost control over the steering, leaving Marjina dead on the spot and Momena and their relative Jamila Khatun injured.

The injured were rushed to the district hospital where on-duty doctors declared Momena dead.

# 3 missing in trawler capsize

Three people went missing as a trawler capsized in the Padma River near Goalondo ferry terminal in Rajbari district on Tuesday night.

They are Abdur Razzak, Samim Uddin and Rafiqul Islam of Bachamara village in Manikganj district.

Abu Taleb, in-charge of Paturia naval police camp, told this correspondent that the trawler with seven people on board was going to Bachamara Char in Daulatpur upazila of Manikganj from Daulatdia in Rajbari.

When the trawler reached near Goalondo ferry terminal at around 10:30pm, it was caught in strong winds amid high tide and sank in the river.

# AL leader grabs part of UP office land

An Awami League (AL) leader has allegedly grabbed a piece of land of Tambulpur Union Parishad (UP) in Pirgachha upazila of the district.

Locals alleged that Shamsul Alam, former president of Tambulpur union unit of Awami League (AL) illegally occupied one decimal of land adjacent to his house on Sunday by demolishing the boundary wall and removing the iron gate of the union parishad to build a concrete structure there.

Abdur Rashid, UP member of the ward, tried to prevent Shamsul Alam and his men from demolishing the boundary wall, but his efforts went in vain, they

said. They further said that Rezwana Ali Bablu, former chairman of Tambulpur UP, put up the boundary wall and the gate during the tenure of the army backed caretaker government in 2008.

Contact, Rezwana Ali Bablu said the gate and the boundary wall were erected on the land belonging to the union parishad. Shamsul Alam has no right to claim the ownership of the land.

Rawshan Jamir Sarder, incumbent chairman of Tambulpur UP, said Shamsul removed the gate and demolished a portion of the boundary wall, saying that these were build on his land during the caretaker government.

"After verifying land records and other papers

relating to the property of the union parishad, we will take necessary steps in this regard," the chairman added.

Shamsul Alam alleged that the then UP chairman in association with local administration captured his land and built the wall and the gate during the army backed caretaker government. "I didn't dare to protest the illegal act of the local administration at that time fearing harassment," he said.

Asked, Upazila Nirbahi Officer (UNO) Aleya Ferdous Jahan said investigation into the matter the matter is going on. The local administration will take necessary measures on the basis of the investigation report." The UNO said.


