

VIOLENCE DURING 48-HOUR HARTAL

125 Jamaat-Shibir men sued in C'nawabganj, Cox's Bazar

As many as 125 Jamaat-Shibir men have been sued on charge of resorting to violence during hartal hours in Chapainawabganj and Cox's Bazar on Wednesday and the day before.

Our Chapainawabganj correspondent reported that 77 Jamaat-Shibir men on charge of attack on law enforcers in Balubagan area of Chapainawabganj town during Jamaat-enforced hartal on Wednesday.

Sub-Inspector (SI) Rawshan Kabir of Sadar Police Station filed a case against the Jamaat-Shibir men with the police station at around 9:10pm. Of the accused, 17 were identified while the rest unnamed.

Jamaat-Shibir activists barricaded the road in Balubagan area of the town at around 12:00 noon. When police and BGB men reached the area to remove the barricades, the pro-

hartal men hurled cocktails at the law enforcers, prompting them to fire rubber bullets and tear gas shells.

Chase and counter chase also took place in the area. Police and BGB personnel fired 15 rounds of rubber bullets and tear gas canisters to disperse the pro-hartal activists, said Bazlur Rashid, officer-in-charge of Sadar Police Station.

Police picked up two Jamaat activists from Balubagan area. The arrestees are also on the list of the accused.

Meanwhile, Sub-Inspector (SI) Monirul Islam of Sadar Police Station filed another case against 71 Jamaat-Shibir men with the police station on Tuesday night on charges of attacking law enforcers on Tuesday, the first day of Jamaat-enforced 48-hour countrywide shut-down.

In Cox's Bazar, police yesterday filed a case against 30 named and 10 to 20 other unnamed activists of Jamaat-e-Islami and its student wing Islami Chhatra Shibir on charge of causing Tuesday's jeep crash on Chittagong-Cox's Bazar highway during the Jamaat-enforced countrywide hartal, reports a correspondent.

Tarek Bin Mokter, a Shibir cadre of Kharulia area, also an accused in a few other cases, has been made the key accused in the case filed by Kamal Hossain, sub-inspector of Cox's Bazar Model Police Station.

On Tuesday evening, a jeep flipped over after being chased by Jamaat-Shibir activists at Kharulia on Chittagong-Cox's Bazar highway.

The incident left jeep passenger Hamdul Haq killed and a few others injured.

Madrasa girl raped

A madrasa girl was raped at Purbo Morichbunia village in Sadar upazila on Wednesday night.

Police arrested a college student named Jahirul Islam, 20 in connection with the incident.

Family sources said Jahirul Islam entered their house at 11:30pm and raped the girl when she was alone in a room.

Hearing scream, her parents came to the room and caught Jahirul red handed. They later handed him over to the police.

The victim was sent to Patuakhali General Hospital for medical test, said Md Monirul Islam, officer-in-charge of Sadar Police Station.

Stern action will be taken against the responsible for the offence after investigating the matter, said the OC.

A case was filed with Sadar Police Station against Jahirul. Police are investigating the matter, the OC said.

Two youths found dead

Police recovered the bodies of two unidentified young men in Manikganj and Sirajganj districts on Tuesday.

In Manikganj, the law enforcers recovered the body of an unidentified youth, aged around 30, in Dighi area of Sadar upazila in the morning, said Officer In-Charge of Sadar Police Station Shafiqul Islam.

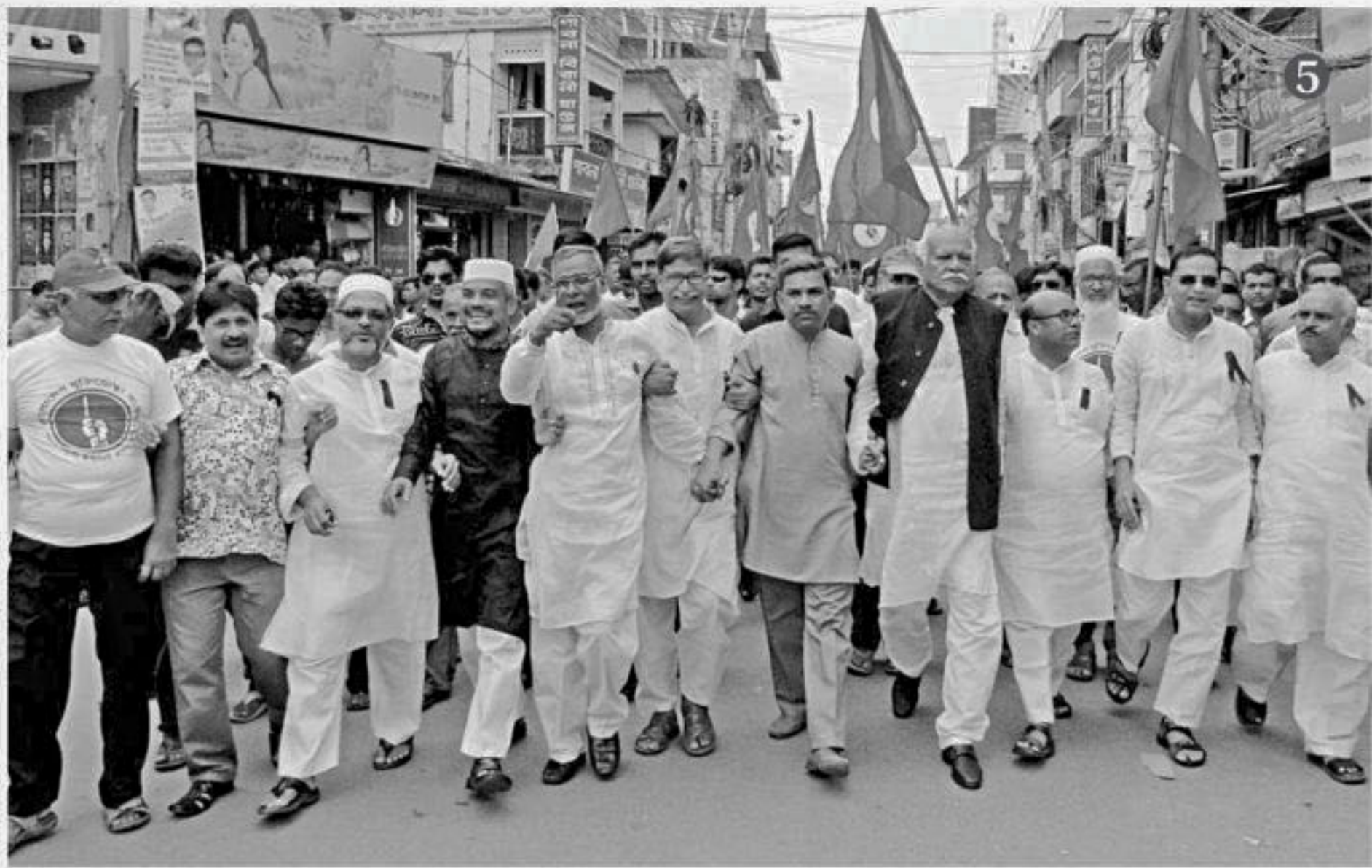
Police suspected that criminals killed the youth and dumped the body in the area.

Away in Sirajganj, locals found the body of an unidentified young man, aged around 25, floating in a canal at Telkupi Moholla in the municipality area on Tuesday morning and informed police.

15 fishermen abducted from Meghna

15 robbers held, two looted trawlers recovered in prompt police action

Robbers kidnapped 14 fishermen from near Baluar Char (landmass emerged from the river Meghna) adjacent to Hatia upazila of Noakhali and Monpura upazila of Bhola districts early yesterday.

Char Nizam police camp sources said a gang of armed robbers swooped on 15 fishermen while they were fishing on board three fishing trawlers in the Meghna River at around 4:00am.

As the fishermen tried to resist the robbers, they opened fire, leaving a fisherman named Md Zakir

injured. The gang took away 14 fishermen along with two trawlers and fishing nets.

Zakir was in another trawler and brought to Charfashion Upazila Health Complex. As his condition deteriorated, doctors of health complex referred him Barisal Sher-e-Bangla Medical College hospital.

Being informed, a police team from Char Nizam police camp led by ASI Guljar Ahmed raided Baluar Char area yesterday morning. They arrested 15 robbers and recovered the two looted trawlers from there.

The arrestees are Abdul Kashem, Lokman, Ruhul Amin, Jahangir, Ismail, Abdur Rab, Babul Mistri, Moin Uddin, Bellal, Burnobi, Nurul Islam, Nurul Islam (2), Kabir, Jamal and Alauddin.

They all are from South Sakuchia union under Monpura and Lalmohan Upazila of Bhola district. Police said the drive is on to rescue the abducted fishermen.

Police early Wednesday rescued 19 of 21 fishermen who were abducted from the Meghna in Monpura upazila of the district on Tuesday night.

SWECHCHHASEBOK LEAGUE LEADER MURDER CASE

Charges pressed against 13 accused in Bogra

Police on Tuesday pressed charges against 13 accused in the case for killing Swechchhasebok League leader Khairul Anam Rekkat in Bogra town in December 2012.

The charged sheeted accused are Arifur Rahman Arif, 26, son of late Habibur Rahman, Shahadat Alam Rumu, 48, son of late Azizur Rahman, Hamidul Haque, 48, son of Basharat Ali, Asaduzzaman Rimon, 30, son of Jahurul Islam, Masud Ahmad, 24, son of Shamim Ahmad, Sajal Kumar Ghosh, 20, son

of Suman Kumar Ghosh, Shutku Shadhin, 25, son of Ismail Hossain, Pintu Mia, 30, son of late Achim Uddin, Mahamudul Hasan, 24, son of late Abul Hossain, Musa alias Jhunak Sarkar, 26, son of late Mehedul Islam of Rahmannagar area; Hari Jewel, 30, son of Kalipada driver of Shabgram area; Mahmudur Rahman Sujon, 28, son of Mamtajur Rahman of Bejora area; and Asha Mia, 20, of Godardara area in Bogra town.

Mizanur Rahman, officer-in-charge (OC) of the

Detective Branch (DB) of police, submitted the charge sheet to the court.

Rekkat, 35, senior joint convener of Swechchhasebok League Bogra town unit, was shot dead at his business centre in Rahmannagar area of the town at around 11:00am on December 17, 2012 by the accused.

Abdul Kaium Ofa, father of the slain leader filed a case with Sadar Police station the following day, accusing 17 people.

After investigation, DB of Bogra submitted pressed charges against 13 people.

 - Examine, the project management systems and performance to express a professional opinion on the overall performance of the project including technical standards, goals and deadlines for achieving project objectives;
