

Woman hurt in bomb explosion in capital

A woman was injured when local criminals exploded crude bombs at Jurain in Shyampur of the capital yesterday.
The victim identified as Roksana Begum, 35, wife of Jahangir Alam, is an employee of a local clinic and resides at East Jurain.
The splinters of the home-made bombs hit her in the chest while she was on a rickshaw.
She was admitted to Dhaka Medical College Hospital.
Shyampur police Sub-inspector Amanullah said a man named Khalilur Rahman, president of ward no-88 of the city unit of Islami Chhatra Shibir, was killed during a hartal.
Local people suspect that the bomb exploded as a protest of the killing of Khalil, he added.
Locals and the victim said the criminals had exploded three bombs in the area as part of their subversive activities.
Police were investigating the incident.



Fishermen and owners of fishing boats under the banner of Marine Fishing Boat Owners' Association form a human chain on Chittagong Press Club premises yesterday demanding a stop to the killing, robbery, looting, and abduction in the Bay. The participants say ten gangs of sea robbers are involved in robbery and kidnaping in the area and 18 fishing boats were attacked and looted by them between July 24 and August 2.

Road crashes kill five, injure six

Five people were killed and six others injured in road accidents across the country yesterday.
Our Moulvibazar correspondent, a person was killed and four others were injured when a bus rammmed the CNG-run auto-rickshaw carrying them at Sherpur on Moulvibazar-Sylhet highway yesterday.
The deceased was Kabir Ahmed Chowdhury, 38, general secretary of Islami Chhatra Shibir municipality unit.
Our Khulna correspondent adds, a youth was killed and two others were injured when a bus collided head-on with a motorbike carrying them at Elaipur intersection in Rupsha upazila yesterday.
The deceased was Goutom Chakraborty, 25, organising secretary of BCL Khanpur union unit of Bagerhat.
Our Dinajpur correspondent reports, Md Rostom Ali, 45, of Dinajpur Sadar upazila, died after a truck hit his bicycle from behind at Kawgaon village in Dinajpur Sadar upazila.
Protesting the accident, locals blocked the road for two hours. Meanwhile in Joypurhat, an unidentified mentally challenged man was killed as a truck hit him at Trimohoni village on Khetlal-Joypurhat road yesterday, said police.
Our Bogra correspondent reports, a schoolboy, Nazmul Hossain, 12, son of Badsha Mia, died after a truck ran him over in Arkatia Bazar area of Dhunat upazila.
Following the accident, agitated locals set the paddy-laden truck on fire and blocked the road for an hour.
Police arrested the truck driver Abu Said and helper Kadam Ali.
Filing of a case was under-process at the time of filing of this report.

Be responsible for ensuring human rights

NHRC chairman tells RU seminar

Prof Mizanur Rahman, chairman of National Human Rights Commission, yesterday urged the country's people to be responsible about their duties to establish human rights.
He was addressing a seminar titled "Human Rights, Democracy and Good Governance: Perspective of Bangladesh" organised by the Faculty of Law at Rajshahi University in its Senate Bhaban.
Prof Mizan said it was not possible to establish human rights without being a law abiding citizen in society.
In his speech, Mizan criticised the politics of students and teachers at public universities.
RU Vice Chancellor Prof Mizanuddin presided over the seminar while Prof Anisur Rahaman, former dean of law faculty, conducted it.

BISWAJIT MURDER CASE Prosecution witness gives deposition

A prosecution witness of the Biswajit Das killing case yesterday told a Dhaka court that he saw some people stabbing a man in front of his office during a road blockade programme enforced by the BNP-led 18-party alliance on December 9, 2012.
Mohammad Saiful Islam, an employee of Intensive Dental Care, was giving his deposition before the Speedy Trial Tribunal-4 of Dhaka.
Later he came to know that the man succumbed to his injuries and his name was Bishwajit, Saiful said.
Another witness, Sub-Inspector Jahedul Haque, told the court that he along with Constable Kamal Hossain made an inquest report of the body and later they handed the body over to Bishwajit's family members around 1:00pm.
Mohammad Habib, another employee of the dental clinic, also gave his deposition. The court fixed tomorrow for the next hearing.

Motorcyclist stabbed by muggers in capital

Unidentified miscreants yesterday stabbed the driver of a motorcycle and snatched the motorbike, four mobile sets and cash and fled in a private car in Banasree of the capital.
The injured motorcyclist Sagor Shikder, 40, was admitted to Dhaka Medical College Hospital.
Contacted, Sagor's wife Nilfar Begum said her husband along with two others was coming home on his motorcycle at about 3:00am.
When they reached Banasree D-block, a private car hit the motorcycle on its side.
The miscreants alighted from the car and took the three hostage at gun point. When the criminals tried to take the motorcycle, Sagor resisted and was stabbed in the right hand, she said.
