The government is intentionally depriving citizen in the enclaves from these rights and has been trying to establish that the exchange is solely a political matter. But it is indeed a constitutional matter, he said.  
"For more than six decades a drama has been staged to suppress the matter which is proved through the RTI," he said.  
On August 25, West Bengal Chief Minister Mamata Banerjee rejected the Land Boundary Agreement (LBA) with Bangladesh in its present form.  
She also asked the Indian government to take consent of the state government and people residing in the enclaves.  
Recent efforts of the Indian government to place a constitutional amendment bill in the Rajya Sabha to ratify the LBA with Bangladesh failed.  
The Trinamool Congress, Asom Gana Parishad and India's main opposition Bharatiya Janata Party lawmakers scuttled a move to ratify the Indian Constitution (119th Amendment) Bill, which intended to give effect to an exchange of enclaves.  
The LBA envisages a transfer of 111 enclaves with a total area of 17,160.63 acres to Bangladesh while Dhaka will transfer 51 enclaves with an area of 7,110.02 acres to India.

A letter signed by Comilla's Depot Manager Masud Talukder on October 23, 2012 states that one Moinul Islam, Sylhet district unit Awami League member, is "allowed to open" a counter in Sylhet's Dakshin Surma area.  
On December 9, the High Court stayed the manager's "permit" following a writ petition filed by three persons - Md Toufik Baksh, Md Shamim Kabir and Md Abdul Alim.  
The three were already running four counters there on a March 14, 2012 approval from the DGM.  
Another letter, signed by Noakhali's Depot Manager Omar Faruque Mehdi on June 11 this year, states that one Shamsher Siraj, Sylhet district unit Krishak League

organising secretary, is "allowed to open" one counter there.  
However, the counter was found to have been removed on July 13.  
Omar Faruque then issued a second letter on July 16, allowing one Mohammad Abdulla to set up yet another counter there. The Daily Star obtained copies of all three letters.  
Toufik Baksh told The Daily Star that they would go to court against the "permit" given to Abdulla.  
Abdulla stated that he was not at fault since a BRTC official had issued the permission.  
Over whether he had played a part in the lack of coordination, BRTC Sylhet Depot Manager Nure Alam said he had informed the head office of the matter.
