## 3 forest robbers held after fierce gunfight

Coastguards rescued two fishermen, kidnapped for ransom seven days ago, following a gunfight with forest robbers in Kateshwar area in the Sundarbans under Koira upazila of the district yesterday.

The law enforcers also arrested three robbers and seized seven firearms and 107 bullets from the spot, said a press release issued by Operation Officer Lt Emdad Ullah of coastguard Mongla

west zone.

Acting on a tip-off, members of the coastguard surrounded the Kateshwar area at 3:00pm on Tuesday and raided a den of the infamous 'Jahangir Bahini' in the area at around 3:50am yesterday.

Sensing the presence of the coastguard members, the robbers opened fire, prompting the law enforcers to retaliate. After an hourlong gunfight, coastguards arrested three members of 'Jahangir Bahini' from the den while other members of the bahini managed to flee.

The arrestees are Amir Ali, 32, son of Mohammad Ali Sheikh of Chadnimukha village and Md Sahajahan Gazi, 26, son of Safayet Gazi of Nayanpashla village in in Shyamnagar upazila of Satkhira, and Md Jobber Gazi, 30, son of Mosharraf Gazi, of Patkuliputa village in Paikgachha upazila of handed over to their fami-

## 11 abducted fishermen yet to be rescued

As 13 days already elapsed, several of 50 victims bought freedom

Although 13 days have already elapsed, 11 fishermen who were abducted for ransom by forest robbers from the Bay of Bengal near Sharankhola upazila of the district are yet to be rescued.

Family members of the abducted fishermen are now passing their days amid fear and anxiety.

They are now begging the mohajan (money lenders) to arrange the ransom money demanded by the robbers to set free the abductees.

M Abul Hossain, president of Sharankhola Upazila Matsyajibi Samity, said they knew nothing about the whereabouts of the 11 fishermen kidnapped by the forest robbers belonging to the notorious gangs 'Shirsha Bahini' and 'Jahangir Bahini'.

Anxious families of the victims gather at the Samity (association) office every day to know whether they could be traced out, he said, adding that they could not gather any information about the hapless fishermen despite making attempts time and

Abul Hossain informed that the robbers demanded Tk five lakh as ransom for the release of each of the 11 fishermen.

In the morning of August 15, the robbers swooped on 500 fishermen while fishing onboard trawlers in the Bay of Bengal near Sharankhola and looted fish worth Tk one crore, fishing nets and other valuables from their possession.

While leaving, the gang abducted 50 fishermen, who hail from different areas of Bagerhat, Pirojpur, Barguna and Bhola, along with four trawlers.

Later, the robbers threatened to kill the kidnapped fishermen unless they were freed within one week through payment of ransom.


Meanwhile, members of Coastguard

the den of notorious 'Shirsha Bahini' in the Sundarbans. On August 17, four more abducted fishermen were rescued from the

Sundarbans under Koira upazila by the coastguard following a gunfight with 'Shirsha Bahini' members. Sources said, a number of kidnapped


