## 18pc gas price hike proposed

# 387 Bangladeshis held in KL so far

Govt moves to bring illegal workers back

Thousands of Bangladeshis will face deportation from Malaysia as the country started a crackdown early Sunday targeting five lakh irregular foreigners staying there.

Malaysian police had already arrested 387 Bangladeshis in the first 24 hours till early Monday, Malaysian English daily The Star reported yesterday.

Other nationals arrested include 717 from Indonesia, 555 from Myanmar, and 229 from Nepal, the daily reported. Expatriates Welfare and Overseas

Employment Minister Khandker Mosharraf Hossain yesterday told the reporters that the

government would bring back the Bangladeshis detained in the ongoing crack-

"Some illegal Bangladeshi people were not legalised due to their own failures. Our high commission asked them to renew their passports, but they ignored the call," he said while some reporters met him at his ministry office in the capital.

Terming the current situation of the country disgraceful, the minister alleged that the agencies that sent those illegal workers were responsible for the workers' suffer-

Syria has asked the United Nations to prevent "any aggression" against Syria following a call over the weekend by US President Barack Obama for punitive strikes against the Syrian military for last month's chemical weapons attack, reported Reuters.

Washington says more than 1,400 people, many of them children, were killed in the world's worst use of chemical arms since Iraq's Saddam Hussein gassed thousands of

Kurds in 1988.

Forces loyal to Syrian President Bashar al-Assad carried out a "massive and coordinated" chemical attack in Damascus on August 21, according a French intelligence report shown to lawmakers yesterday, a government source said.

On the other hand, Assad warned in an interview published yesterday that a regional war could break out if Syria is attacked, reports CNN.
