Detective police detained Hefajat-e Islam leader and former state minister for religion and social welfare Mufti Mohammad Wakkas at the capital's Malibagh Monday.
During Hefajat's May 5 rally at Shapla Chattar, Wakkas threatened to oust the government within that night.
Before the rally, thousands of Hefajat men had set fire to shops, police outposts and vehicles as evening fell.
Wakkas, superintendent of Madaninagar Madrasa in Jessore, was elected lawmaker as an independent candidate from Jessore-5 constituency in 1986.

they were hung upside down. Their [victims] wounds were wrapped with acid-soaked cloth. Later, the victims were killed and thrown at the nearby well and bushes."
The prosecutor said Azharul was "involved" in torturing two persons of Gupta Para and Betpatti respectively in Rangpur town from mid-November to early December 1971.
The rest of the six charges against Azharul include torture and killing of 12 persons at Dakhiganj Cremation Ground in Rangpur town on April 3, 1971.
He was also allegedly involved in the killing of 15 unarmed Bangalees of Dhap Para in Badarganj on April 16, 1971 and looting of the houses of the deceased.
Police arrested Azharul at his Moghbazar home in the capital on August 22 last year after the tribunal issued an arrest warrant for him for his alleged wartime offences.

Unidentified miscreants shot a man, who looks after Jubo League Dhaka City North unit Organising Secretary Shakhawat Hossain Chanchal's business, in the capital's Uttar Badda last night.
Ashrafur Islam Swapon, 30, was admitted to a local hospital, said Badda police.
Inspector Kamrul Faruk said Chanchal was absconding and one of the prime accused in a case filed over killing Riazul Haque Khan Milky at Gulshan on July 30.
An unknown person after calling by cellphone brought Sawpon to Uttar Badda kitchen market where another person standing there shot him in the back, he said.

Road crashes kill 5

Five people were killed and one other was injured in separate road accidents in the country yesterday and Monday.
Our staff correspondent reports, a police constable of Armed Police Battalion was killed and another injured after an oncoming truck hit the motorbike carrying them at Daur intersection on Beribadh in the capital's Turag yesterday.
The deceased was Mizanur Rahman, 25. Injured Masud is undergoing treatment at Dhaka Medical College Hospital.
Our Bogra correspondent adds, a schoolgirl was killed when a Dhaka-bound bus of Akota Paribahan hit her at Bazadighi on Bogra-Noagaon road under Dupchanchia upazila yesterday.
The deceased was Shathi Akhtar, 07, daughter of Hasen Ali of the upazila.
Our Chittagong correspondent adds, a schoolboy was killed as a speedy truck of BSRM of Baro Awlia area ran him over in the area of Sitakunda upazila of Chittagong yesterday, said police.
Deceased, Taslim Uddin, 12, of the upazila, was a class VI student of Sonaichhari High School.
Our Kushtia correspondent reports, a truck driver and his helper were killed when another truck ran them over while there were trying to fix their vehicle on Kushtia-Rajshahi highway at Shimultola in Mirpur upazila on Monday.
The victims are Abdur Rana, 32, and Khokon Biswas, 22, of the town A case was filed in this regard.

He also denounced the detention of Hefajat-e Islam leader Mufti Mohammad Wakkas, who is also secretary general of Jamiat-e Ulema-Islam, a component of the 18-party alliance.
"The cases filed against him [Wakkas] are politically motivated," Fakhrul said.
