## School playground remains under water for 2 months

Over 430 kids suffer in Jamalpur

The field of Bogabaid Pura Government Primary School at Bogabaid village in Jamalpur municipality has remained under water for about two months, much to the nuisance of teacher and students.

Established in 1950, the school was nationalised in 1973 and it now enrolls 430 children in six classes from pre-primary to Class V in the school.

"We cannot conduct assembly of students and other co-curricular activities as the school field went under knee-deep water in mid July. Sometimes water enters the rooms of classes

one and two. The situation is likely to continue a few more days," Md Abdul Awal Ansary, headmaster of the school, told this correspondent during his visit there in late August.

"The situation arisen as the surrounding low-lying lands and ditches had been filled with earth for human settlement last year. During the last monsoon too, the field remained under water for about two months as the rainwater could not pass due to lack of drainage system.

"As kids like to play and walk in the water during the recess and after school hours, some are affected

with water-borne diseases.

"We informed the municipality mayor, also a former student of the school, of the problem and requested him to solve it, but to no effect," the headmaster said.

Several students including Ponir Ahmed and Shahriar Pranto of Class V and Kabya and Milon of Class IV said they were missing assembly classes and other co-curriculum activities due to the situation.

Municipality Mayor Shah Md Wares Ali Mamun said, "The problem cannot be solved in a short time. A big plan is needed to arrange drainage system at the village to solve the problem."

## People join highway blockade demanding lifting of restrictions

Locals blocked the Khulna-Satkhira Highway in Dumuria upazila bazar area yesterday, demanding that Nasiman and Karimon (locally-made three wheelers) be allowed to ply the highway.

Sources said, about 300 local people, including drivers of the shallow engine-run vehicles, put up barricade on the highway in the area around 11.00am, demanding withdrawal of restriction on movement of the vehicles on the highway and an end to harassment of their operators by police.

Due to the blockade, vehicular movement on the highway was disrupted for about an hour, causing immense suffering to the commuters.

Around 11:30am, Narayan Chandra, ruling party MP from Khulna-5 constituency, visited the spot and expressed solidarity with the demand of the

agitators.

The protesters left the scene at about 12.00pm on assurance that the matter would be for discussion at the upcoming district co-ordination meeting.

A high police official on condition of anonymity, said that the communications ministry prohibited plying of Nasiman and Karimon on the highways across the country to avoid risks of accidents.

In this situation how could a ruling party legislator express solidarity with the demand, he posed.

The lawmaker could not be contacted for his comments.

On the other hand, Anwar Hossain Sona, joint secretary of Khulna Bus-Mini Bus Owners' Association, threatened to go for a tougher agitation programme if the authorities give permission for plying the illegal vehicles on the highway.

## Freight train derails disrupting train links

Rail Communications on Dhaka-Chittagong and Dhaka-Sylhet routes remained suspended for nearly four hours after a freight train derailed in the district yesterday morning.

Train service was restored around 11:45am through an alternative railway track, said Md Nurul Islam, station master of Narsingdi Railway Station.

Sources said, around 8:00am when three bogies of a Dhaka-bound container train from Bhairab veered off the tracks near

Daulatkandi Railway Station in Raipura upazila.

The local railway authorities immediately managed an alternative line to resume the service.

Later, the Chittagong-bound Mahanagar Express and Dhaka-bound Prabhati Express, which got stuck at Amirganj railway station and Bhairab railway station respectively following the derailment, left the stations.

Meanwhile, a relief train from Akhaura Railway Junction reached the spot and was trying to salvage the derailed compartments till filing this report around 12:30pm, the sources said.

## Assault on college teacher, wife triggers protest

Teachers and students of Panchbibi Degree College blocked Hili-Joypurhat road in Joypurhat on Tuesday, protesting an attack on wife and son of a lecturer of the college by a group of transport workers over a week ago.

They also formed a human chain, demanding immediate arrest of the attackers.

Police said, wife and son

of Md Abu Hasnat Mondal, a lecturer of the college in Joypurhat district, boarding a night coach of SR Paribahan, was going to Dhaka on August 27.

When the bus reached Food Village, a highway restaurant in Bogra, its staff allegedly led by Md Rony assaulted the duo publicly for their delay in returning to the vehicle.

Hasnat then filed a complaint with SR Paribahan authorities, demanding punishment to

the attackers.

Eight days into the incident, the authorities failed to take any steps in this regard, which forced the teachers and students to take to the street on Tuesday.

They withdrew the blockade after two hours at 12:00pm following an assurance by the law enforcers of taking punitive action against those responsible for the offence, said Nur Hossain, officer-in-charge of Panchbibi police station.
