Gonojagoron Mancha submits memo to MKA

Gonojagoron Mancha protestors submitted a memorandum to the home minister yesterday, demanding immediate arrest and punishment to their attackers.

Six representatives of the anti-war criminal campaigners, led by the mancha spokesperson Imran H Sarker, urged Home Minister MK Alamgir at his office to implement their demand. Imran said that Alamgir assured them of taking steps to bring the perpetrators, terming them as Jamaat-Shibir activists, to book immediately.

The memorandum states that the protestors believe the recent series of attacks were pre-planned to stop their movement in spreading awareness against anti-liberation forces.

Two activists were killed and six others injured in attacks at different parts of the country since the inception of the movement.

The perpetrators were unpunished in most cases allowing such incidents to occur frequently -- the memorandum added.

The activists took out a procession around 12:00noon from the Gonojagoron Mancha at Shahbag in the capital and stopped at the Doyel Chatter. The team of six representatives were then escorted by the police into the ministry.

Citing testimonies of 11 prosecution witnesses and some documentary evidence, Prosecutor Rana Dasgupta yesterday placed arguments on charges from the 12th to 17th. Earlier, he placed arguments on the other charges.

The prosecution produced 35 witnesses to prove their charges while the defence produced three witnesses, including Alim's son, to prove that the accused was in hiding during the war. The prosecution could not produce any witness to support the fourth and fifth charges.

According to the relevant laws, after the prosecution completes their arguments, the defence will place their arguments. The prosecution, if necessary, may give replies to defence's arguments. Then the court will either keep the case waiting for verdict or fix a date to deliver judgment.

Prosecutor Tureen Afroz is expected to place arguments on legal aspects today.
