

RAIN LIKELY



Light to moderate rain or thundershowers accompanied by temporary gusty wind is likely to occur at many places over Chittagong and Sylhet divisions and at a few places over Dhaka, Khulna, Barisal, Rajshahi and Rangpur divisions till 6:00pm today.

Moderately heavy falls are also likely at places over the country, Met Office said. Day and night temperature may remain nearly unchanged over the country.

The sun sets in the capital today at 6:04pm and rises tomorrow at 5:45am.

Country's highest temperature 36.6 degree Celsius was recorded yesterday at Sylhet and lowest 24.7 degrees at Srimangal.

5 held with 7 stolen cars

Detectives on Thursday arrested five members of a carjacking gang at different parts of the capital and Sylhet city, and recovered seven stolen private cars from their possession.

They are Khalek, 33, Rony, 31, Rajib, 29, Ali Ahammed, 47, and Azim, 38.

Acting on a tip-off, a team of DB police nabbed three carjackers from the capital's Mohammadpur, Mirpur and Nabisco areas on Thursday, and recovered five private cars from their possession, said Mokhlesur Rahman, additional deputy commissioner of police (DB south), at a press briefing in the Dhaka Metropolitan Police media centre yesterday.

As per their confessional statements, the detectives in another drive held two other carjackers of the same gang from Sylhet city, and also recovered two private cars from their possession, he added.

The gang used to hijack cars from the capital and send those to other districts for sale, said Mokhlesur, quoting the carjackers.

Their main targets were old cars parked at different places in the capital as they could easily open the car locks by using normal keys, taking advantage of weakening the locking system of the cars, he mentioned.

School kids to play vital role

Speakers at the daylong Dhaka divisional round of the "Junior Climate Champions" competition yesterday opined that school students, being tomorrow's assets, will play a vital role in combating climate change in the future.

Underscoring the need for creating awareness on climate change among school students, they said the spirit of the new generation would be an inspiration for senior citizens too.

Around 700 students from classes VI to X of 50 Bangla and English medium schools participated in the competition's three categories -- poster and painting quiz and extempore speech -- in the capital's Viqarunnisa Noon School and College.

After the evaluation of the submissions,

classes VI to VIII in one scale and classes X and XI in another, 30 students, 10 from each category, were selected for participation in the national round.

The national round, to be contested by those selected from the Sylhet, Chittagong and Dhaka divisional rounds, is scheduled to be held in the capital's The Daily Star Centre on September 20. The prize-giving ceremony will be held in Bangla Academy the same day.

A total of 30 students were selected from each of the Sylhet and Chittagong rounds, held on August 30 and September 6 respectively.

The Daily Star and HSBC initiated the competition, aiming to create awareness among the young minds on climate change and its effect on the country and around the globe.
