Criminals cut youth's tendon, another's elbow joint

Criminals cut tendon of a youth and elbow joint of another at Phultola under Shajahanpur upazila of the district yesterday afternoon.

The youths were identified as Faisal Ahmed, 28, son of Freedom Fighter Abdus Sattar of Phultola area and Piash Mia, 32, son of Chan Mia of Bejora area under Shajahanpur upazila

of the district.

Police said, a local gang called the two youths of Gondagram area of the upazila to meet them at Phultola at about 2:30pm and cut the elbow joint of Faisal and tendon of Piash, leaving them critically injured.

Later local people rushed them to Shaheed Ziaur Rahman Medical College and Hospital (SZMCH) for treatment but Piash's leg

had to be amputated as it was almost cut off, they said.

Contacted, ASP (Sadar and Media) of Bogra Gaziur Rahman, said that Faisal was an accused in the case filed for killing of Jubo League activist Bush in the area a few days ago.

Faisal and Piash might have been attacked by the men of Bush due to past feud. However, it would be clear after investigation, added the ASP.

12 boys back from Indian jail

Twelve Bangladeshi boys returned home on Monday night after languishing for two years in an Indian jail. Indian authorities handed them over to BGB here after due formalities. The returnees are Sumon, 10, Syed Khalifa, 14, Shahin, 13, Babu, 11, Zahidul, 13, Jasim, 16, Mostafa, 15, Sumon Haldar, 15, Alam Mollah, 10, Joynal, 16, Jasim Laskar, 16, and Shafiqul, 15. They all hail from different areas of Bhola, Bagerhat and Pabna districts. BGB sources said a team of Indian police had arrested the 12 boys from Mumbai town in India two years ago for illegally entering the country.

Schoolboy stabbed

A schoolboy was stabbed by criminals in Galachipa upazila on Sunday noon. He was Antor, 14, is a student of class ten at Panpatti High School in the upazila. He was admitted to Patuakhali General Hospital with serious injury. Police said an altercation took place between Antor and one Mahmud, 30, of the area, over a trivial matter on his way to school. Later a gang of 5/6, led by Mahmud, gathered at Muktijoddha Haat near the school and called Antor out of his classroom with the help of a local boy Imran. The criminals then stabbed Antor indiscriminately, leaving him seriously injured.

Idol vandalised

Criminals vandalised idol of a Hindu God at Dasherhat Sarbojonin Durga Mondop at Aralia village under Tazumuddin upazila yesterday. Puja Celebration Committee sources said both ears of God Ganesh were found broken early in the morning. Choton Chandra Das, general secretary of the committee said they were yet to identify the criminals. Acting upazila nirbahi officer Chowdhury Rowshan Islam and ASP Mahafuzur Rahaman visited the spot and assured the people of taking necessary action.

Two school teachers jailed

A mobile court on Monday night sentenced two school teachers to jail for indecent acts during school hours in Uzirpur upazila. Police and locals said, Jahangir Kabir, headmaster and Mahmuda Begum, assistant teacher of Bamrail Government Primary School engaged in an altercation and then scuffled at about 11:40am in the school compound in presence of the students. Both the teachers later filed allegations against each other to the upazila administration. Shohrab Hossain, Uzirpur upazila nirbahi officer, formed a mobile court at night and sentenced the headmaster to six-month and the female teacher to three-month imprisonment.

Defamation suit against 4

A defamation suit has been lodged against four people including Fuad Hasan, Mymensingh correspondent of The Daily Surjodoy, a Bengali newspaper published from Dhaka, on charge of publishing, fabricated and motivated news items. The other accused in the case are chief editor of the daily Major (Retd) Modasser Hossain, its managing editor Hossain Md. Minar-uz-Zaman and executive editor Emran Amin. Md. Zakir Hossain, office assistant at the emergency department of Mymensingh Medical College and Hospital (MMCH) filed the case with No-1 Cognizance Court of Senior Judicial Magistrate on Monday noon. In his complaint, Zakir Hossain said, Fuad Hasan recently demanded TK. 25,000 from him and as he did not respond to his illegal demand, Fuad published four 'false and fabricated' reports within September 12 to September 19.

3 outlaws held, arms seized

Law enforcement agencies have arrested three outlaws and recovered two firearms from their possession in Kushtia and Meherpur districts.

In Meherpur, a joint team of police raided the house of Hisab Ali, 35, a top cadre of Janajuddha faction of outlawed Purbo Banglar Communist Party (PBCP-ML) at about 11.30am yesterday.

Police arrested him and recovered one pistol and two bullets from his possession.

In Kushtia, a team of Rapid Action Battalion (Rab-12), Kushtia unit arrested two top cadres of outlawed Gono Mukti Fouz (GMF) in Kumarpur terminal area in Kumarkhali upazila at about 12.00pm on Monday.

The arrestees were identified as Taslim Uddin, 30 and Kazi Siddiq, 34.

Rab also recovered a foreign made revolver and two bullets from them.

BNP activist accused of killing Jubo League leader murdered

A BNP activist was hacked to death allegedly by Awami League men in Chaugachha upazila of the district on Monday night.

The dead, Atiar Rahman, 35, of Jagannathpur village, was a charge sheeted accused in upazila Jubo League president Ashraf Hossain Asha murder case, police and locals said.

According to witnesses, Atiar was having tea at a tea stall near his house at around 8:00pm. A gang of nine, including local Awami League activists Ashiq, Ahad, Alam and Selim, reached there. They swooped on Atiar, hacked him with sharp weapons and left the scene.

Locals and family members rushed Atiar to Jessore Medical College Hospital where the doctors declared

him dead.

Officer-in-Charge Golam Rahman of Chaugachha Police Station said Atiar was a charge sheeted accused in Jubo League president Asha murder case and was on bail. Locals said Ashiq, one of the attackers, is nephew of the slain Jubo League leader.

"After primary investigation, we revealed that the attack on Atiar was in revenge for the killing of Asha," the OC said, adding that they have launched a drive to arrest the attackers.

Leaders and activists of BNP upazila unit brought out a procession with the coffin of Atiar at Chaugachha Bazar yesterday. They demanded immediate arrest and exemplary punishment of the killers.

Criminals strangled a class nine student on Monday night at Phulhori Baganpara village under Shaikhupur upazila of the district.

The deceased was identified as Al-Mamun, 15, son of Abdul Mannan of the village. He was a student of Phulhori Secondary High School.

Mamun's father Abdul Mannan, a rickshaw puller, said his son used to pull his rickshaw on holidays. He demanded exemplary punishment of the culprits.

Officer in-charge (OC) Anwar Hossain of Shaikhupur police station said, on Monday at around 9:00pm, Mamun was reading at his house. Two unknown people called him out, strangled him and dumped the body near the school ground.

Locals found the body in the morning and informed the police.
