

# Intra-party rivals foil MP's meet

30 injured in Pirojpur

Thirty people were injured as Principal Shah Alam, ruling Awami League lawmaker from Pirojpur-2 constituency (now Pirojpur-1 after delimitation), faced attack by intra-party rivals when he came to attend a public meeting at Sriramkathi Bazar in Nazirpur upazila under the district yesterday.

As Shah Alam reached Sriramkathi launch terminal with 1,000 followers in 20-25 trawlers to attend the meeting at around 10:30am, dozens of local Chhatra League and Jubo League activists attacked them, preventing their getting into the meeting venue.

The attackers threw bricks at their opponents and beat them with sticks and iron rods, causing injuries to around 30 people.

Two of the injured were sent to Barisal Sher-e-Bangla Medical College Hospital and others were admitted to Nesarabad upazila health complex.

Forced to return to his upazila Nesarabad, Shah Alam later arranged a press

conference at Bharatkathi village.

Shah Alam alleged that the attackers are followers of AKMA Awal, AL lawmaker from what was Pirojpur-1 constituency before the recent delimitation.

"I had informed my party men including upazila and union level AL leaders, even lawmaker Awal about my programme at Sriramkathi Bazar. But Awal's men attacked us," he said.

After the recent delimitation of three constituencies in Pirojpur, two lawmakers from ruling AL AKMA Awal and Principal Shah Alam have got Pirojpur-1 as their constituency. The constituency comprises Pirojpur Sadar, Nazirpur and Nesarabad upazilas.

Party sources said Awal and Shah Alam are in loggerheads as both of them are anxious about AL nomination from this constituency.

Meanwhile, Abdul Khalek, officer in charge of Nazirpur police station, claimed that no incident of attack occurred at Nazirpur.

Master Amulya Ranjan Halder, Nazirpur upazila unit leader of AL, also evaded the matter.

### Woman killed after rape

A young woman was killed after rape at Kawali Binni village under Madan upazila of the district on Tuesday night. The dead was identified as Hasina Begum, 25, daughter of late Amirul Islam of the village. Police said, when Hasina went out of her room to respond to the call of nature a gang raped and then murdered her. Family members and neighbours found her body in front of her house in the morning. Officer in-charge (OC) of Madan PS Kamrul Alam Mollah told this correspondent that a gang allegedly led by Abdul Gani of same village killed Hasina with sharp weapons after rape.

### Fish poisoned to death

Fish worth Tk 12 lakh in a pond and an enclosure of a union parishad member was poisoned to death by criminals at Sher Ali Madanpur village in Manirampur upazila of the district early Tuesday. The affected fish farmer is Kasimnagar union parishad member Shafiar Rahman, son of Hasan Ali Gazi of the village. His family members alleged a local gang, including Alam, Nur Nabi, Mukul, Joni, Shariful and Mahbub poured poison in the fish enclosure and pond of Shafiar in the dead of night following an attempt to murder case filed against them. On September 22, the gang swooped on Shafiar's family members over previous enmity, leaving him critically injured.

### Boy 'commits suicide'

A teenage boy allegedly committed suicide in the district town yesterday. The deceased was identified as Md. Oliur Rahman Ovi, 15, son of Md. Saidur Rahman of Balubari area under Dinajpur Municipality. Ovi was a class nine student at Dinajpur Zila School. Police said, the parents of the boy entered the bedroom at around 11:00am yesterday as their son was not waking up from bed and found him hanging from the ceiling.

# 820 hapless women to get jobs for five years

Eight hundred and twenty destitute women, 10 each from 82 unions of the district, are going to be employed for five years under the government's Rural Employment and Road Maintenance Programme.

The selection in the dis-

trict started on September 14.

The beneficiaries -- divorced or widowed women or those abandoned by husband, and belonging to age group 18 to 35 years, will be employed for daily wage of Tk 150 to look after the rural roads for small repair and maintenance for five years, said Belal Hossain,

executive engineer of LGED in Gaibandha.

"They will get Tk 90 for daily work while the rest Tk 60 will be deposited with the bank account against their name for five years. After five years, each of these women will get a substantial amount that will help their rehabilitation," he said.

## Acid thrown on woman, college going daughter

A woman and her college going daughter sustained serious burn injuries as unidentified criminals threw acid on them at Rajoir Upazila Health Complex with the help of some neighbours. Later, the doctors of the health centre referred Nasima and Mitu to Faridpur Medical College Hospital.

Being informed, a police team from Rajoir Police Station visited the spot yesterday. Officer-in-Charge Mofazzal Hossain said they are trying to unearth clue to the incident.

No case in this connection was filed with the police station as of 6:00pm yesterday.

## JCD man held over human trafficking

Members of Rapid Action Battalion (Rab) arrested a local leader of Jatiyatabadi Chhatra Dal at Imambari Bazar in Nabiganj upazila on Tuesday on charge of having connection with a human trafficking gang.

The arrestee is Nurul Amin, 28, president of Kaliarbhanga union unit JCD in the upazila.

Rab-9 Sreemangal camp sources said a team of the elite force arrested Nurul from the area for his suspected involvement with the gang for long.

There was also an allegation against him of realising ransom from the family members of expatriates by kidnapping them abroad and there were cases filed against him with Nabiganj police station, said the sources.

However, officer in-charge of the PS Jahangir Alam denied the matter of cases against Nurul, also president of local CNG-run Auto-rickshaw Workers' Association.

Protesting the arrest, drivers of local CNG-run auto-rickshaws blocked Habiganj-Nabiganj Road for about two hours.

## Indian handed over to BSF

An Indian national was handed over to BSF on Tuesday after completion of his jail term in the district prison for intrusion.

Border Guard Bangladesh (BGB) handed over Fazal Mia, 35, son of Abdul Aziz Mia of Kakripura village under Mankarchar police station of Dhubri district in Assam, to Indian Border Security Force (BSF) on Nakugaon border in Nalitabari upazila.

BGB sources said Bangladeshi police arrested Fazal from Roumari border on September 7, 2011 for his illegal border crossing. Later, he was sent to Sherpur prison where he served six months' jail.

# BSF picks up youth, injures teenage boy

Indian Border Security Force (BSF) picked up a Bangladeshi cattle trader from Munshipur border point in Damurhuda upazila of Chuadanga district early yesterday, reports a correspondent.

The victim is Miajan, 35, son of Fakir Mijai of Munshipur village, said an official of Border Guard Bangladesh (BGB).

Locals said a BSF team from Modhupur camp caught Miajan when he along with some Bangladeshi cattle traders went to Indian territory to bring their cattle. However, the rest managed to flee.

Major Mehedi Hasan, deputy commanding officer of BGB-6 battalion, said we have sent a protest letter to BSF to return Miajan.

In Kurigram, a Bangladeshi teenage boy was shot and injured by BSF men on Balarhat border in Phulbari upazila on Tuesday night.

The victim is Asadul, 17, son of Abdul Zalil of Khalisha Kotal frontier in Naodanga union, reports our correspondent.

Bazlur Rashuid, officer in-charge of Phulbari police station, said a patrol team of BSF men opened fire on a group of cattle traders, including Asadul, at 8:30pm when they went to the border area to bring their cattle.

Asadul sustained bullet injuries in his right ear and right eye during the firing, said the OC.

Asadul was taken to Phulbari Hospital and then shifted to Rangpur Medical College and Hospital as his condition deteriorated, he said.
