## KSA plans crackdown

No more amnesty in Malaysia

The Saudi Arabian government will start a massive crackdown on illegal foreign workers after the end of the amnesty that expires on November 4.

It warned that the migrants staying illegally in the kingdom would be fined and jailed for two years after the grace period.

"Over three lakh Bangladeshis have already received consular services under the amnesty. We hope the remaining ones will take the advantage before the amnesty period expires," Emdadul Haque, labour counsellor of Bangladesh embassy in Riyadh, told The Daily Star over the phone recently.

Urging the Bangladeshi workers to take the advantage within the stipulated timeframe, the labour counsellor said they would have to face punishment otherwise.




