No Kalk with U-19s

The national U-19 football team left here for Iraq yesterday to take part in the qualifiers of the AFC U-19 Championship without Dutch goalkeeping coach Kees Kalk.

Kalk was supposed to accompany the U-19 side along with his compatriots Rene Koster, Lodewijk de Kruif and fitness trainer Muhammet Yamali. Kalk and Yamali were supposed to part relation with the Bangladesh Football Federation after the completion of the qualifiers.

"Kalk did not go with the team due to his sudden sickness," informed BFF general secretary Abu Nayeem Shohag. However, it has been learnt that Kalk did not agree to go with the U-19 side as his payment for September was not paid fully.

The Dutch goalkeeping coach had decided to leave his job, a month before his four-month contract expires on November 15.

Harmison retires

Stephen Harmison, the former England paceman who has failed to make a single first-class appearance in Durham's title-winning year, announced his retirement on Sunday.

The 34-year-old, who took 226 Test wickets for his country, told regional newspaper Sunday Sun that he had "known for a while" that he would be calling it a day at the end of the 2013 season.

Gunners go top

Arsenal returned to the top of the Premier League on Sunday after Jack Wilshere rescued a point for them in a 1-1 draw at West Bromwich Albion, while rivals Tottenham Hotspur suffered a shock 3-0 thumping by West Ham United.

Chelsea relied on two goals in two minutes by substitutes Eden Hazard and Willian late in their match at Norwich City to give them a 3-1 win that lifted them to third in the league with 14 points from seven games, two behind Arsenal and Liverpool.

A week after stunning champions Manchester United 2-1 at Old Trafford, West Brom were up to their old tricks against visitors Arsenal as they took a 42nd-minute lead with Claudio Yacob's powerful downward header.

After somehow escaping further damage from more West Brom chances, Arsenal drew level in the 63rd minute when Jack Wilshere made up for his poor performance until that point when he smashed in a deflected shot from 20 metres out.

The point, which put Arsenal ahead of Liverpool on goals scored, will be all the sweeter for Arsene Wenger's side on a day their bitter north London rivals Tottenham lost ground on the leaders after a mauling by West Ham at White Hart Lane.

Second-half goals from Winston Reid, Ricardo Vaz Te and Ravel Morrison, whose was a superb individual effort after picking the ball up in his own half, secured only a second league victory of the season for Sam Allardyce's side.

Earlier in the day, Chelsea had grabbed three points at Norwich after it had looked like their fourth-minute lead from an Oscar goal would not be enough as Anthony Pilkington levelled for the hosts in the 68th minute.

The equaliser seemed to shake Chelsea awake and the introduction of Hazard and Willian changed everything.

Chelsea broke quickly after a Norwich corner and Hazard's shot was pounced on by John Ruddy but the ball carried on past the keeper and over the line in almost slow motion on 85 minutes.

Another counter-attack wrapped up the win a minute later as Willian curled in a first-time shot.

Perfect eight for Barca, Atletico

Alexis Sanchez struck twice and created a goal for Neymar as Barcelona recovered from conceding early to maintain their perfect La Liga start with a 4-1 win at home to Real Valladolid on Saturday.

An eighth victory in eight games for the champions restored their five-point advantage over arch-rivals Real Madrid who needed a Cristiano Ronaldo goal in the fourth minute of stoppage time to secure a 3-2 triumph at Levante earlier.

Atletico Madrid, the only other team with seven wins from their opening seven matches, also join Barca on 24 points at the top of the table with a 2-1 win against Celta

Vigo yesterday.

Diego Costa made up for the disappointment of his non-inclusion in the Spain squad by scoring twice. The Brazilian-born striker was not included in Vicente del Bosque's squad on Friday as the paperwork that will make him eligible for the world champions was not completed in time.

However, he again made his case for a future call up with another two goals to take him top of the La Liga scoring charts with 10 goals, two ahead of Lionel Messi.

It could have been even better for Costa had he not seen a first-half penalty saved by Yoel Rodriguez.

However, he made amends by tapping home from Filipe Luis' cross just before half-time and then driving home a second 17 minutes after the break.

On Saturday, Valladolid forward

Javi Guerra silenced the Nou Camp when he headed in a corner in the 10th minute but Barca were level four minutes later, Alexis lashing the ball home from just outside the penalty area.

Cristian Tello squared for Xavi to sidefoot the ball in seven minutes after the break before Neymar sent Alexis clear on the right in the 64th minute and he sent a precise shot into the far corner.

The Chilean returned the compliment by setting up Brazil forward Neymar to make it 4-1 six minutes later as Barca continued their impressive form under new coach Gerardo Martino.

Real are flying in Europe after resounding Champions League victories over Galatasaray and FC Copenhagen but turned in another disappointing domestic performance at Levante following last

Roma jive on Totti

Two first-half goals from captain Francesco Totti helped AS Roma make it seven wins out of seven as they extended their Serie A lead to five points by sweeping Inter Milan aside

3-0 at the San Siro on Saturday.

A wonderful breakthrough goal by Alessandro Florenzi a minute before the break completed the rout and gave Rudi Garcia's side 21 points, raising hopes in the capital of a first league title since 2001 after a near-perfect start to the season that has seen them score 20 goals and concede only one.

Inter, who failed to break Roma down despite Federico Balzaretti being sent off with 11 minutes left for a rash tackle on Ricky Alvarez after having already been booked, stayed fourth on 14 points.

"I didn't only like the collective spirit the team showed but also the fact that they played with grit when it was necessary. We played like men," Garcia told Sky Sport Italia.

He was cautious about any title talk, however.

"There's too long to go to be talking about winning the league. What we had today was a leader up front in Totti who showed us the way," he said.

Roma took the lead in the 18th minute

after a bright start, Gervinho finding the 37-year-old Totti who crashed home the opener through a crowd of Inter defenders.

There was controversy over Roma's second goal, a 40th-minute penalty from Totti that came after a period of intense Inter pressure in which Fredy Guarin hit the post with a long shot.

After chasing down a long pass, the impressive Gervinho glided past Esteban Cambiasso before being chopped down by Alvaro Pereira.

Referee Paolo Tagliavento pointed to the spot but replays showed the Ivorian was just outside the area.

Totti showed his class for the third goal, juggling the ball on the edge of his own area with his back to goal before delicately flicking it to Bosnian midfielder Miralem Pjanic who raced up field before sliding a perfect pass to Florenzi who finished with a first-time shot which sent the 5,000 travelling fans into raptures.

A Mumbai double

A furious finish from Mumbai Indians' middle order propelled them to a monumental total before a chase-breaking over from Harbhajan Singh snuffed out the last of Rajasthan Royals' spirit, driving the IPL winners Mumbai to their second major title of the year, as they won the Champions League final by 33 runs at the Feroz Shah Kotla in Delhi yesterday.

The Royals bowlers had been disciplined in their first 12 overs, which only cost them less than seven an over, but a Rohit Sharma onslaught unseamed their resolve and the remaining batsmen took maximum toll on a waning attack. Glenn Maxwell provided the most frenzied death-over innings, mauling 37 from 14, but Sharma, Dinesh Karthik and even Harbhajan struck at over 200 to help plunder 120 runs from the last eight overs of the innings.

Eighteen-year old Sanju Samson was imperious in Royals' response, and he led Ajinkya Rahane in a 109-run second-wicket stand that provided a fine base for the chase. But even as Rahane completed his fourth fifty on the trot, the Royals' scoring slowed, and Harbhajan eventually sunk the opposition in the 17th over that claimed three wickets and cost only four.

Siddikur third Qualifies for CIMB, HSBC

Siddikur Rahman settled for a joint-third place finish at the Mercuries Taiwan Masters which earned him a place at the lucrative CIMB Classic slated for later this month. Despite closing with a five-over-par (77), in tough conditions, Siddikur managed to end the event on joint third at three-over-par (291), which earned him a paycheque of 36,000 dollars. Siddikur was delighted to claim his place at the CIMB Classic with his result at the Mercuries Taiwan Masters, which was last qualifying event for players to break into the top-10 on the Asian Tour Order of Merit.

It was also the penultimate event for leading players on the merit list vying for a place in the WGC-HSBC Champions in China.

"It was a great week especially playing under such tough conditions. I'm not disappointed even though I didn't play that well today. Only Thaworn broke par today and that says a lot about the conditions out there," Siddikur told the Asiantour.com after the day's play.

Australia's Scott Hend grabbed the winner's cheque as he posted a two-over-par (74) to for a winning total of three-under-par (285).

Siddikur's next event is the CJ Invitational in South Korea, hosted by KJ Choi, which starts on Thursday.
