# JU deadlock takes toll on students

The ongoing deadlock at Jahangirnagar University is taking a heavy toll on its students, as they have been missing classes and examinations one after another, leaving timely completion of their studies in doubt.

The students have so far missed 47 days from their academic calendar due to the unrest on the campus, particularly the teachers' movement that began soon after the appointment of Prof Anwar Hossain as vice chancellor in May last year.

Apart from that, the country's lone residential university has enjoyed 118 days of official holidays since then.

Already behind schedule by around three to four months, students and teachers fear that with only two months left of this academic session, the ongoing stalemate will prolong session jams.

The students demand an immediate end to the deadlock. "We don't want our academic lives to be ruined like this," said Manzurul Hossain of the anthropology department.

Meanwhile, the teachers agitating under the banner of "Sadharan Shikkhak Forum" yesterday released Registrar Abu Bakar Siddique and Deputy Registrar Abu Hasan from confinement in their offices.

They had confined the two for the last eight days in protest at the appointments of three deans to the faculties of law, business administration and biological science.

### Education altered, for the better

There was a time when Rakib's parents, farmers by occupation, had decided to involve him in farming, since they could not afford a proper education for him. It was not until the teachers at the Basic School System (BSS), a school for drop-outs in Tangail, discovered Rakib Rahman and urged his parents to admit him in the school, that he finally began a new and confident chapter in life. Today, he is a student of class 5 and loves to design and build furniture in carpentry class. "I want to be an interior designer when I grow up," smiles the young wood enthusiast.

In 1978, Dr Muhammad Ibrahim, a celebrated professor of physics, established the Centre for Mass Education in Science (CMES), and later on established the Basic School System (BSS) in 1981, as a part of CMES. Dr Ibrahim's idea was to have young dropouts return to school and grow an interest in science and general education, including vocational training. "I came up with the idea of BSS mainly to address the needs of adolescent dropouts," says Dr Ibrahim. "So far, the response has been tremendous. The mission is to educate each and every child in
