SUNDAY'S ARRESTS Sirajganj BNP calls hartal

Sirajganj unit of BNP will enforce a half-day hartal in the district today, protesting arrest of its activists in the town.

District unit president and former state minister for power Iqbal Hasan Mahmud Tuku announced the hartal from its party office yesterday.

At least 24 BNP men were arrested following a clash with cops in the town on Sunday. The clash ensued when BNP men attacked the house of local Awami League (AL) leader Habibe Millat Munna from a procession in Boro bazaar area in the afternoon.

At least 20 people, including a few policemen, were injured during the clash. Immediately after the incident, police filed a case with Sirajganj Sadar Police Station, accusing 100 identified and 400 unnamed BNP men.

They arrested 24 of the accused, raiding different areas in the town early yesterday. Advocate Mokaddes Ali, general secretary of BNP district unit, claimed that law enforcers arrested over 70 party men.

Iqbal Hasan Mahmud Tuku alleged that police ransacked the houses of BNP men in the name of search operation on Sunday night and arrested many BNP activists. He demanded immediate release of the party men.
