Hatirjheel stinks as sewage surges into water

Delay in setting up of a water treatment plant in Dasherbandi area and illegal dumping of industrial and household waste are every day turning bad to worse the water of Hatirjheel-Begunbari canal in the capital.

The Dasherbandi plant has now become pivotal to keep the water of the canal clean, said Prof Mujibur Rahman of Bangladesh University of Engineering and Technology, whose team had done the Hatirjheel project's drawing design and the feasibility study.

The waste treatment plant has been designed to treat 6 lakh cubic metre of water per day. Once its construction begins, the plant will take three years to start operating, said Prof Mujibur.

The Hatirjheel canal connects with the river Balu, which later joins the Shitalakkhya River. So with this canal getting polluted the water of the two rivers also is also getting contaminated.

On the delay in starting the treatment plant work, Managing Director of Dhaka Water Supply and Sewerage authority (Wasa) Taqsem A Khan said they were now looking for donors to fund the Tk 1,500-crore water treatment plant.

China, India strike deal on defence

Beijing allays New Delhi's fears over Brahmaputra dam

China and India yesterday signed an agreement on border defence cooperation after a stand-off along their disputed frontier in April fuelled fears of conflict between the Asian giants.

The agreement, signed after talks between Indian Prime Minister Manmohan Singh and his Chinese counterpart Li Keqiang, also said both countries agreed to strengthen their cooperation further on trans-border rivers that is aimed at allaying

ing India's concerns over new dams on the Brahmaputra and facilitating the exchange of flood data.

Manmohan Singh, visiting Beijing to seek a breakthrough in the territorial row that has soured relations for decades, witnessed the signing of the pact alongside Chinese Premier Li Keqiang.

The agreement will "help to maintain peace, tranquillity and stability in our border areas", Li said following the ceremony.

Mob beats 2 to death in Ctg

Locals chased them after they shot Jubo League leader

A mob beat two men to death when they were fleeing after shooting a Jubo League leader in Raozan upazila of Chittagong yesterday.

The deceased are Mozammel Hoque, 38, and Sumon, 28, both hailing from Panchkhain village under Bagoan union in the upazila.

The bullet-hit Jubo League leader Abdul Khalek, 35, of Panchkhain Dorgabari, was admitted to Chittagong Medical College Hospital (CMCH) with bullets in the belly and back.

Khalek, also a member of ward No 5 of Bagoan union, said he was returning home from the market on an easy-bike around 11:00am.

As soon as he had reached Panchkhain School, four BNP
