hope to complete it within this week," Chief Election Commissioner Kazi Rakibuddin Ahmad told reporters at the EC Secretariat yesterday.

"In the code of conduct, we will mention issues including when we will start exercising our authority, how we will restrict activities of political parties, and how a level-playing field will be ensured," he said.

As per the constitution, the 10th parliamentary election is to be held from October 27 to January 25.

Replying to a query on why the EC is late in amending the code of conduct, the CEC said, "Frankly speaking, we waited for a consensus among major political parties. We did not want to shut the door for political consensus by quickly imposing restriction on political parties."

The CEC also welcomed the recent conversation over telephone between Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina and BNP Chairperson Khaleda Zia saying it is a positive sign for positive consensus.

Asked about the parliamentary standing committee on law ministry's proposal to drop the RPO provision that makes it mandatory for a person to be a member of a political party for three years to contest in the general polls from that party, he said, "The committee did not seek our opinion on this issue. I cannot comment on it."

The deceased was Abdur Rahman, 75, of Natun Colony village in the upazila.

Our Dinajpur correspondent reports, a man was killed when a shallow engine-run three-wheeler hit him from behind on Dinajpur-Karimullahpur in Dalmora yesterday.

The deceased was Md Abdus Sattar, 45, son of Md Safiuddin of Chawra village in Dinajpur Sadar upazila.

Our staff correspondent from Chittagong adds, an old man died as a covered van hit him while he was crossing the Dhaka-Chittagong highway in Banshbaria area of Sitakunda upazila yesterday morning.

The deceased Md Shah Alam, 60, hailing from Banshbaria area of Sitakunda, worked as a guard in a ship breaking yard.

son of BNP Chairperson Khaleda Zia and late president Ziaur Rahman.

Mamun said the charges were false, fabricated and concocted and that the court could not punish him based on the 13 statements.

Anti-Corruption Commission (ACC) filed the case against Tarique and Mamun in October 2009 over Tk 20.41 crore siphoned out to Singapore between 2003 and 2007.

Tarique was arrested in 2007 during an anti-graft crackdown by the then military-backed caretaker government. He obtained bail in some of the other 17 cases filed against him and has been in London since September 2008 seeking treatment.

The court issued an arrest warrant against him on August 8, 2011 and on May 26 cleared the way for ACC to seek Interpol's help to arrest him.

## BOKHTIAR MURDER

# One of arrested four confesses to killing

Four alleged robbers have been arrested in connection with the killing of Bokhtiar Mohammad Latif and the robbery incident in their house on September 13.

Bokhtiar, an A-level student of Academia, was shot dead by "robbers" in front of his parents in the capital's Jatrabari around 3:00am while he was playing games at a laptop. They also looted some valuables from the house.

The arrestees are Khalil, 34, Akhter, 35, Rustum Ali, 50, and Jalal Uddin Jalal, 45.

Confessing to the killing, Khalil told The Daily Star that "He (Bakhtiar) tried to grab me, so I shot him. I don't know how it happened."

Monirul Islam, joint commissioner of detective and criminal intelligence division, Dhaka Metropolitan Police (DMP) at its media centre told reporters yesterday that following confessional statement from Swapon and Habib who were arrested during another robbery incident on October 10, the law enforcers arrested the four in the capital on Saturday night. Swapon and Habib were also shown arrested in the Bokhtiar murder case.

Bokhtiar's father Zahid-al-Latif who was present at the press briefing told reporters that "The tall one (Rustum) initially looked familiar. When he began to describe the incident it matched exactly with my wife's description."

"One of them had switched off the TV so it became totally dark. Besides they had covered their faces," said Samsunnahar Ferdousi, mother of Bokhtiar, at the briefing. "Yet I could recognise them from the way they described the incident and their physique."

Police also recovered one revolver with four bullets from the gang.

"Akhter attempted to commit robbery in the house twice but failed because of the dogs that guarded the house. So, they killed one of the dogs by feeding it poison with meat," said Monirul.

Eight persons were involved in the house robbery. Two, including informer Kana Sattar, are still absconding, said Monirul.

A Dhaka court yesterday granted police four days remand for quizzing the arrestees.
