Five killed in blasts near Modi's rally

At least five people were killed and 66 injured yesterday in a series of bomb blasts near the venue of BJP prime ministerial candidate Narendra Modi's rally in Patna minutes before he reached there to address a huge gathering.

Hours before the multiple explosions, a crude bomb went off in a newly constructed toilet at Patna railway station, two kilometres from the venue in Patna, capital of the eastern state of Bihar where the party had shared power as a junior coalition partner of ruling Janata Dal (United).

Vimal Karak, deputy superintendent of Patna Medical College Hospital, said the five had died of blast injuries and the injured were being treated for the same injuries.

Five low-intensity bombs detonated on the outer periphery of the Gandhi Maidan, the venue of the rally, said Indian Home Secretary Anil Goswami.

One of the bombs exploded in front of a cinema near the
