The authorities have imposed a ban on engaging children in all kinds of work related to dry fish processing at Dublarchar in Shoronkhola upazila.

A circular was issued in this regard by the Forest Department in the third week of last month. The circular also warned

that tough legal actions would be taken against those found guilty of violating the ban.

Meanwhile, the fishermen and owners of several dry fish processing units are passing busy time in the seven char (shoal emerged from riverbed) areas, including Dublarchar, in the upazila.

Around 30,000 people remain engaged in the dry fish units of Dublarchar alone every season.
